The Y.W.A.C. of Blessing entertained the Girl Reserve Club with a party at the community house. Quite a few attended.


On December 23, the Y.WC.A. women were invited by the Cirl Reserves to attend their Recognition Cermony, which was followed by a Christmas play and party.

For the first time Blessing won first in Conference 58-B. The meet was held in Boling where our team encountered no opposition for senior tennis.






















Horseradish must claim to be one of the two--either horse or radish---to that consumers will know whether to surrender red or blue stamps when buying it.







Dearest Marcolla,


I have had such a wonderful trip that I must tell you all about it.
