Last Will and Testament

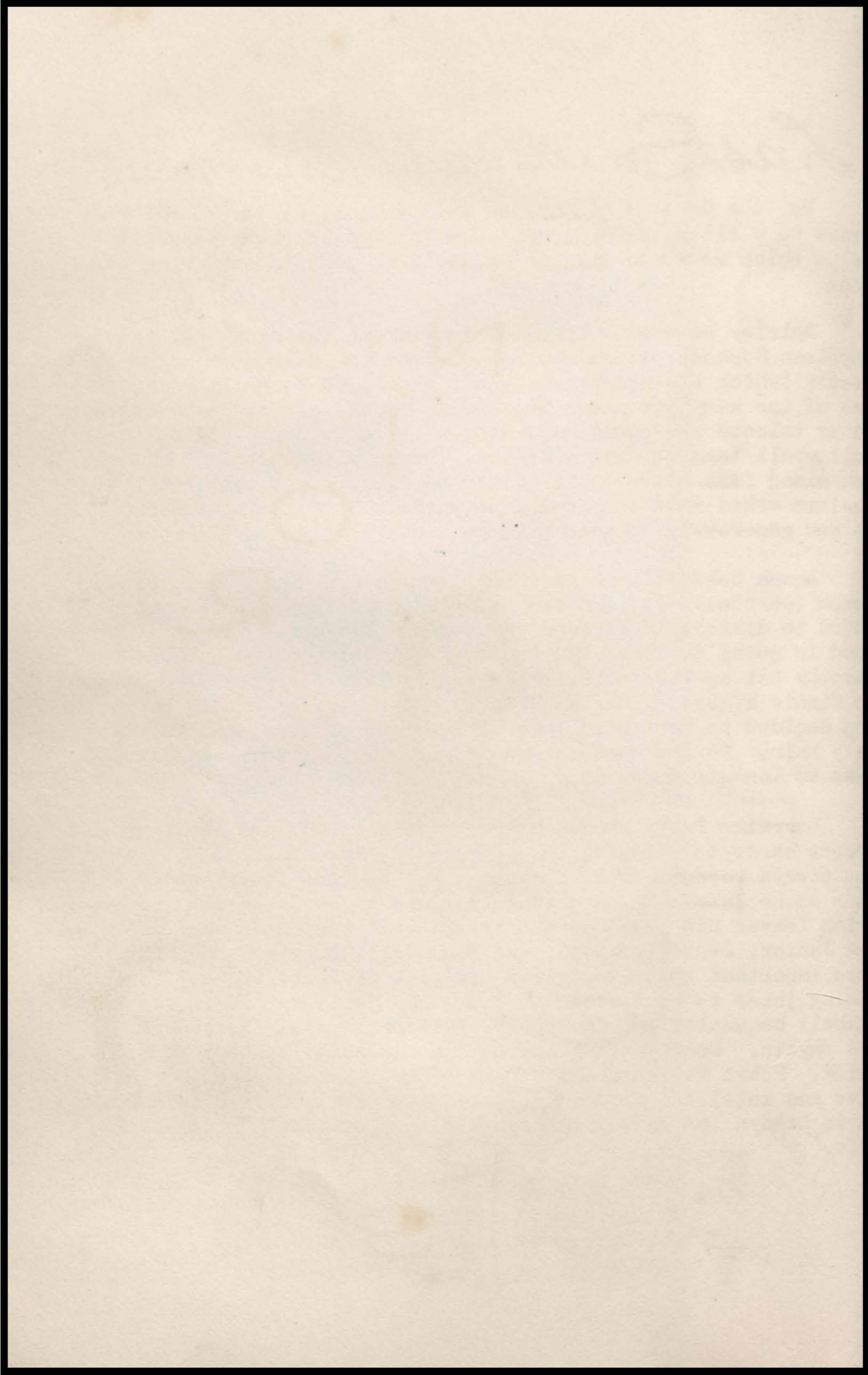
We, the Seniors of Markham High School, as the school year draws to a close, find ourselves with various items of great value which we would like to bequeath to certain deserving persons.
