SENIOR PROPHECY

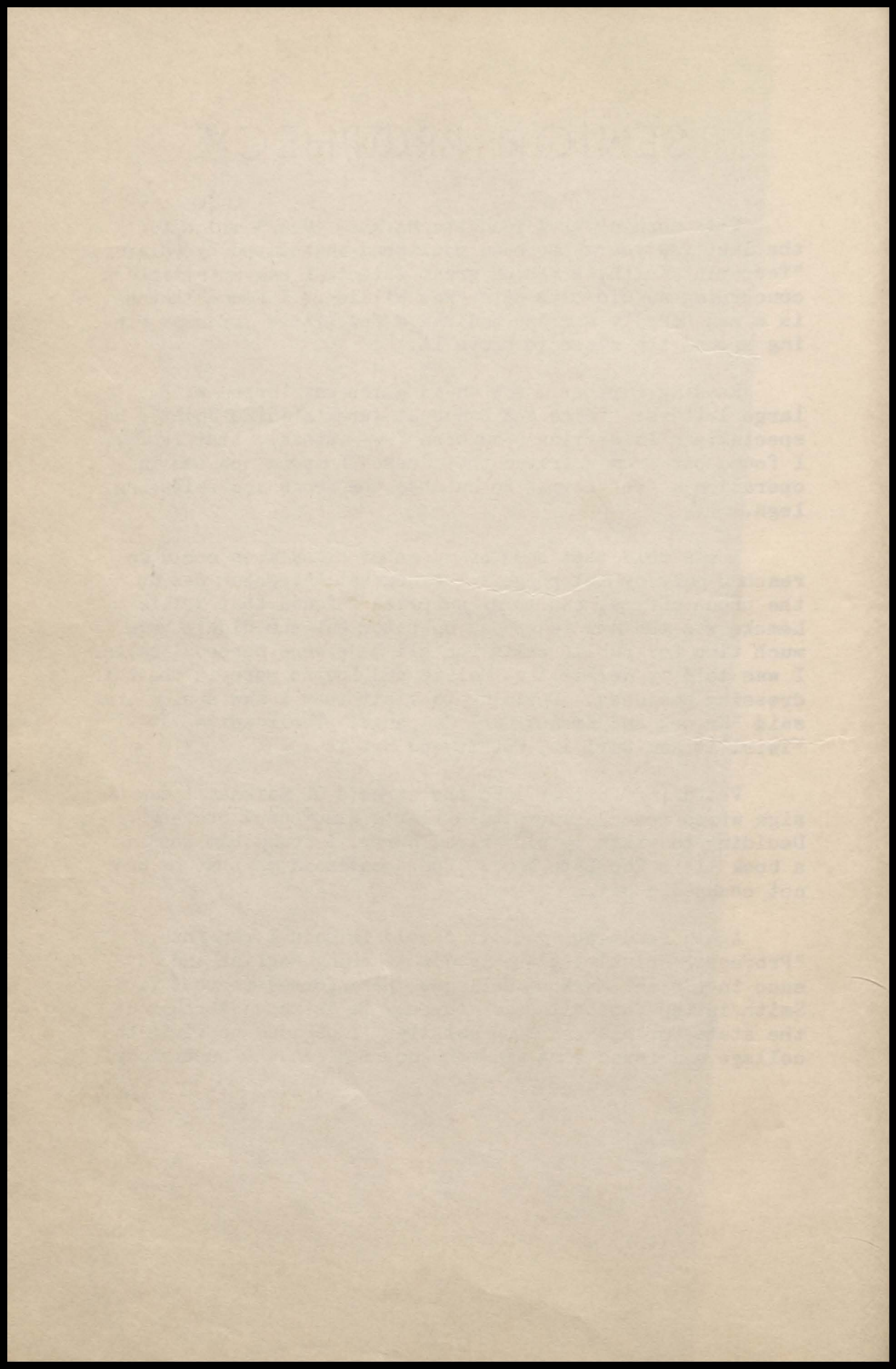

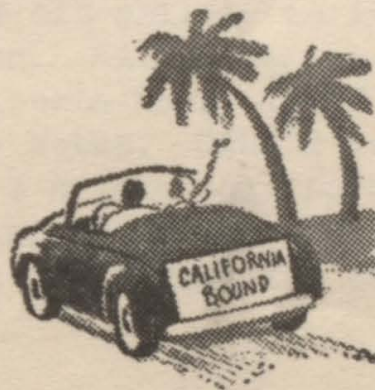

Coming to the conclusion that my old pals were doing all right for themselves and contributing to civilization and the general good of the world, I said farewell to the "great" and slowly rode away.

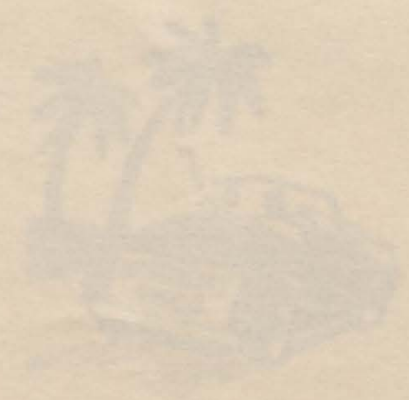
