


Foreword

May this book preserve for you the memories of Markham High that you wish to remember.



Never again will you have such carefree and happy days even though to some of you they may not seem as such.





I appreciate this opportunity to bring you the principal's message for your year book. Through the cooperation of each of you, your teachers and your administrators, this wonderful book is made possible.



Senior Prophecy


While traveling one summer in the green and wild jungles of wildest and deepest Mexico I happened to drive onto

JOE HENRY SENKYRIK is Fashion Editor for the Ladies Home Journal, which has been his favor-



I, GLADYS ROBERTSON, leave my saxophone playing ability to Ella Mae.


