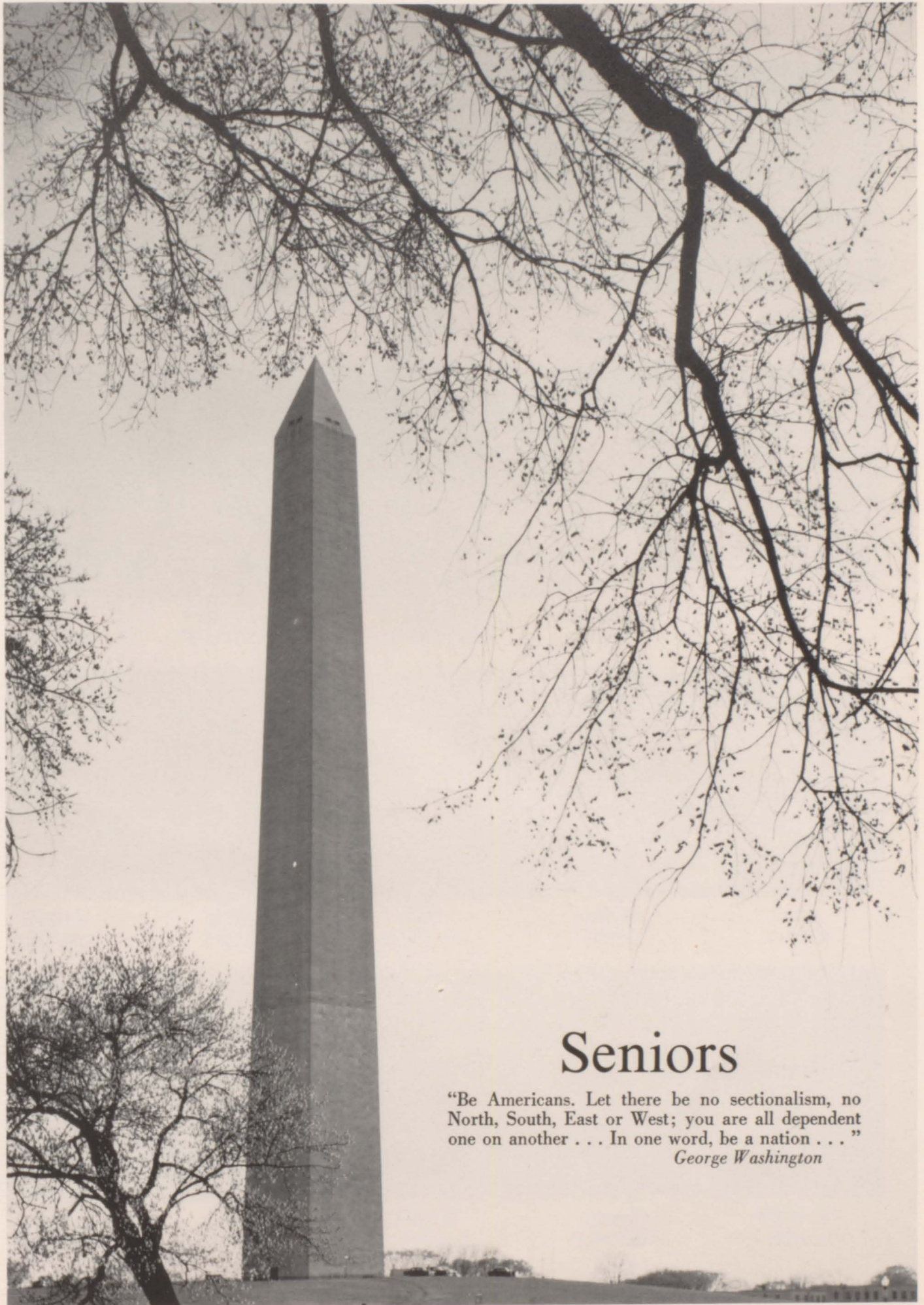
In Memoriam
Charles Donald Shreve
October 27, 1932 — November 14, 1975



Charles D. Shreve became principal of our high school on November 21, 1974, following the death of J. G. Smith, Jr. on November 13. He died November 14, 1975, after suffering a heart attack in his office.

One of the highlights in his career at Palacios High School came in 1964 when he led the Sharks to the state football championship in his first year as head coach. He also served in the vocational trades program and as assistant principal.

Mr. Shreve had a great sense of humor, a zeal to help every student, and practiced fairness to all. His morals were high, and he carried the air of a winner. For these reasons, we prefer to remember him as he looked when at work.

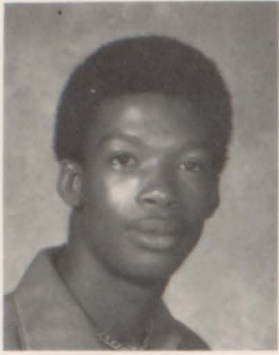

The Plains Indians

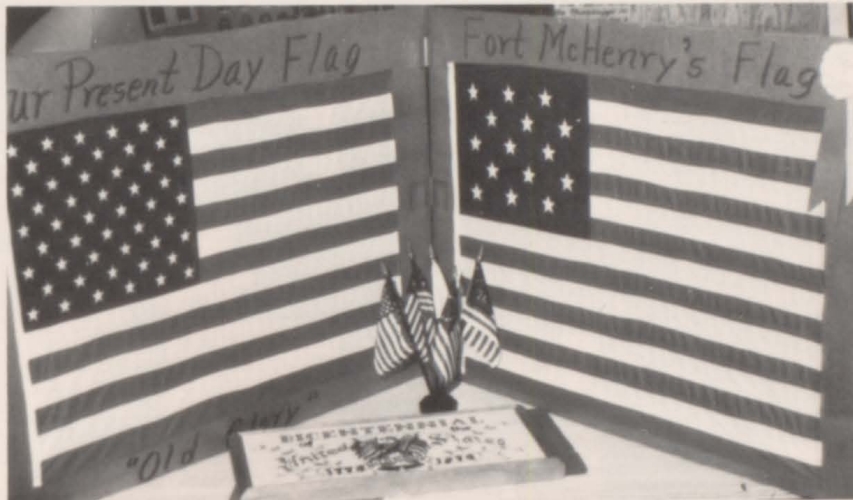
