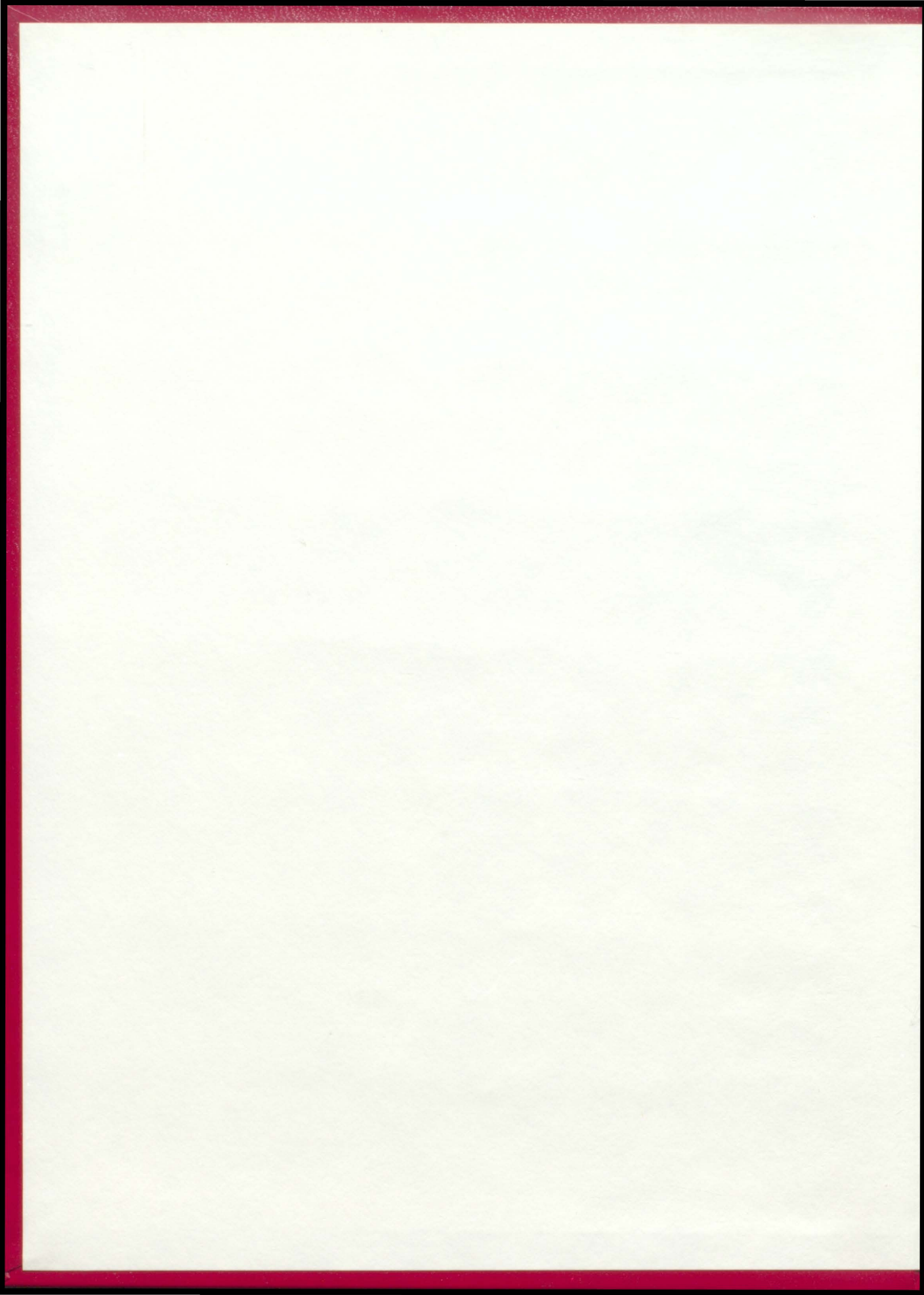
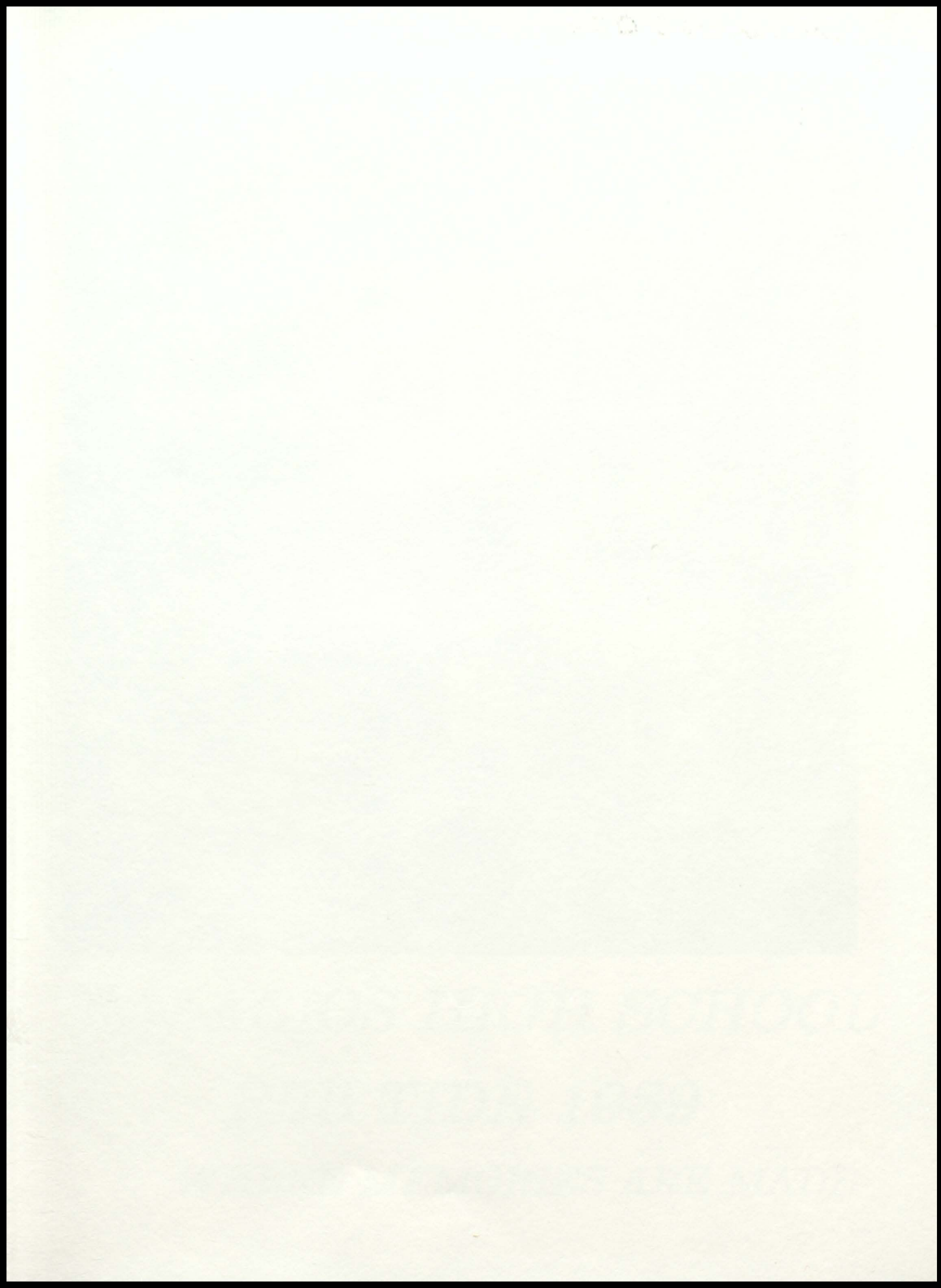


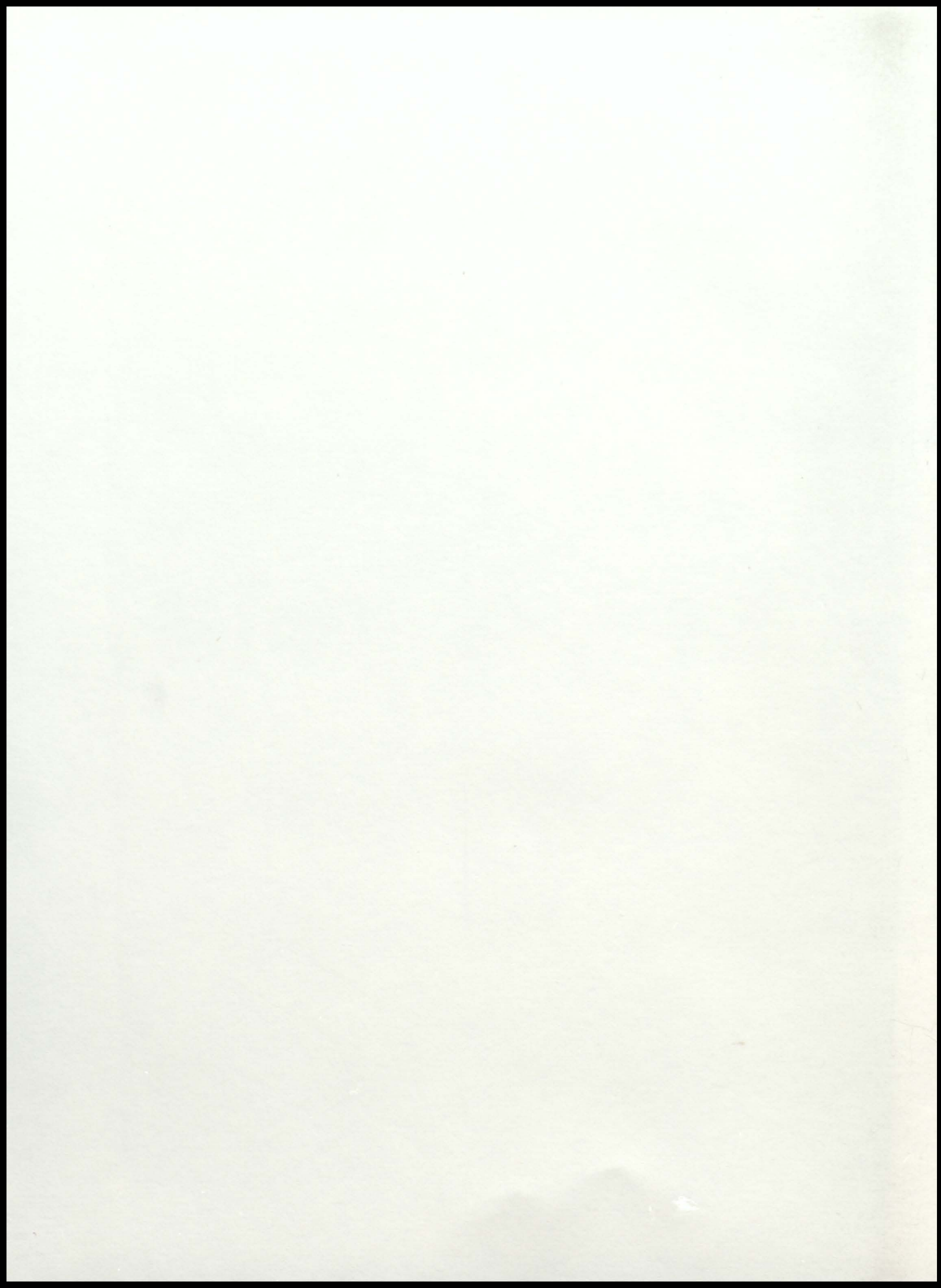

Practices Before School

Although summer break lasts three months for most students, many PHS students begin preparing for the next school year when their summer begins. Many of these students spend their entire summer break working towards making the upcoming school year better than the previous one.

One group of students that spends their entire summer working at school is the cheerleading squad. They begin their summer by making the necessary preparations for camp. Each year they give one week of their summer and spend it learning new cheers and chants. After the cheerleaders return from camp, they spend the remainder of their summer decorating the lockers and the halls for the first day of school.

On August 8 PHS wel-

comed three other groups of students to the school as they began preparing themselves for the next year. The first of these groups was the band. Each year the band begins workshops three weeks before school starts for four hours daily. They work on teaching the freshmen how to march and eventually put together the first half-time show. They also learn all of the music they will play at the pep rallies and in the stands at the football games.

The second group that came in on August 8 was the girls volleyball team. They began two-a-day workouts in order to be ready for their first scrimmage. Morning workouts consisted of extensive conditioning while the afternoon workouts concentrated on volleyball skills and

techniques. Those volleyball players who were also in the band had a separate workout in between the two regularly scheduled practices.

The final group that began practicing on August 8 was the football team. They began early each morning and worked out until mid-morning. Then late in the afternoon they came back to school for their final practice of the day. These guys had two scrimmages before school started and all

their hard work paid off.

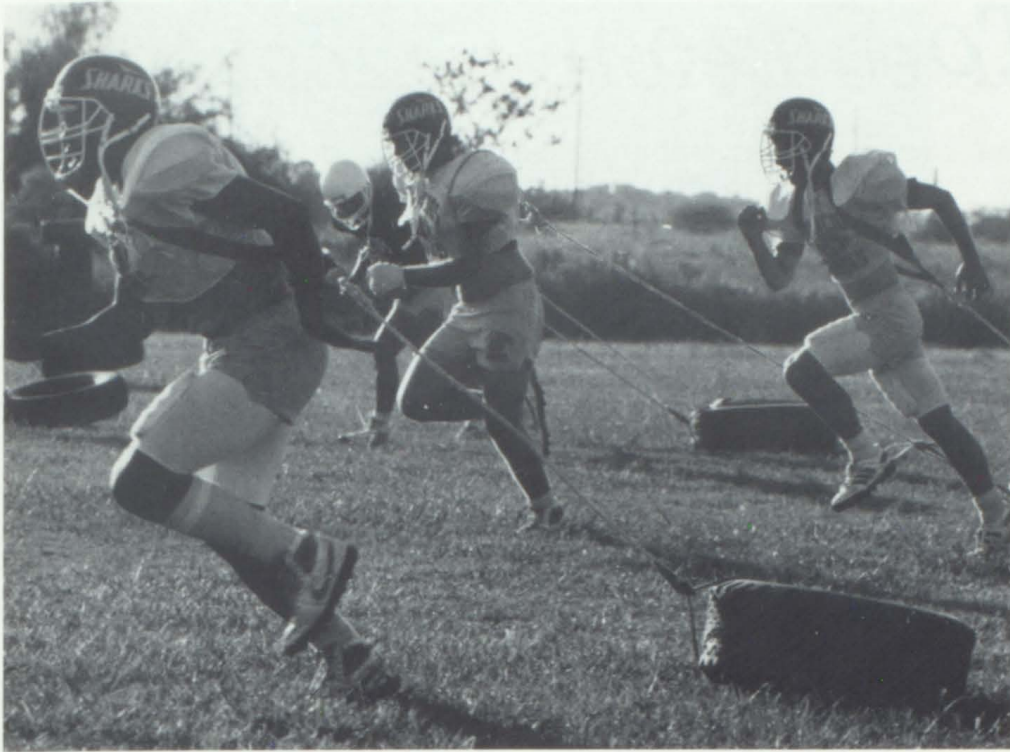

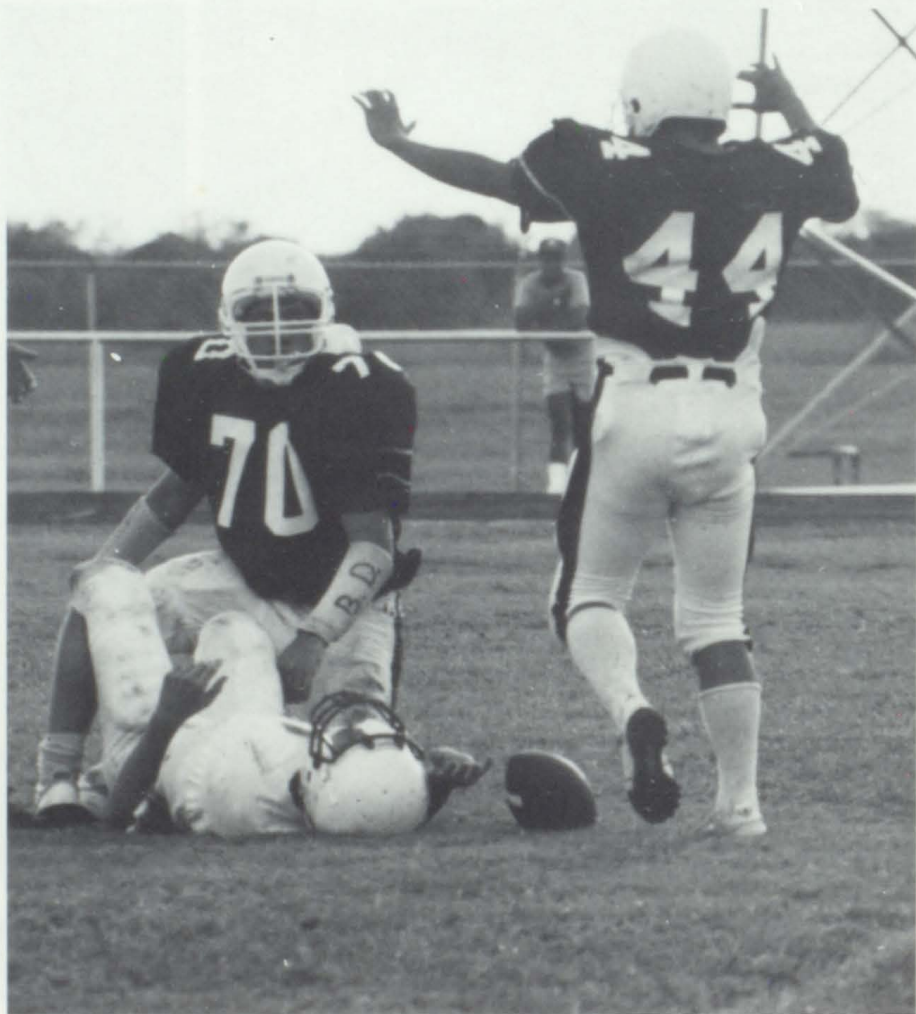

School spirit, pride and involvement started the 1988-89 school year off with a BANG!



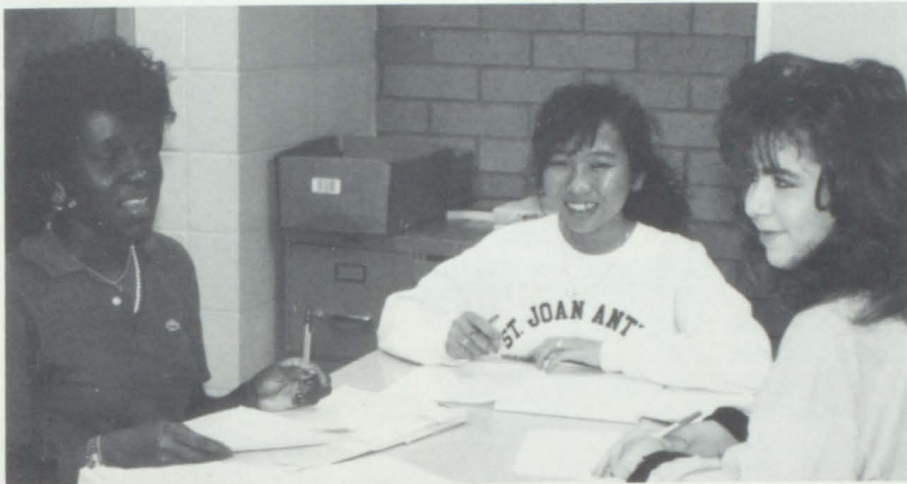

New Faces In PHS Office

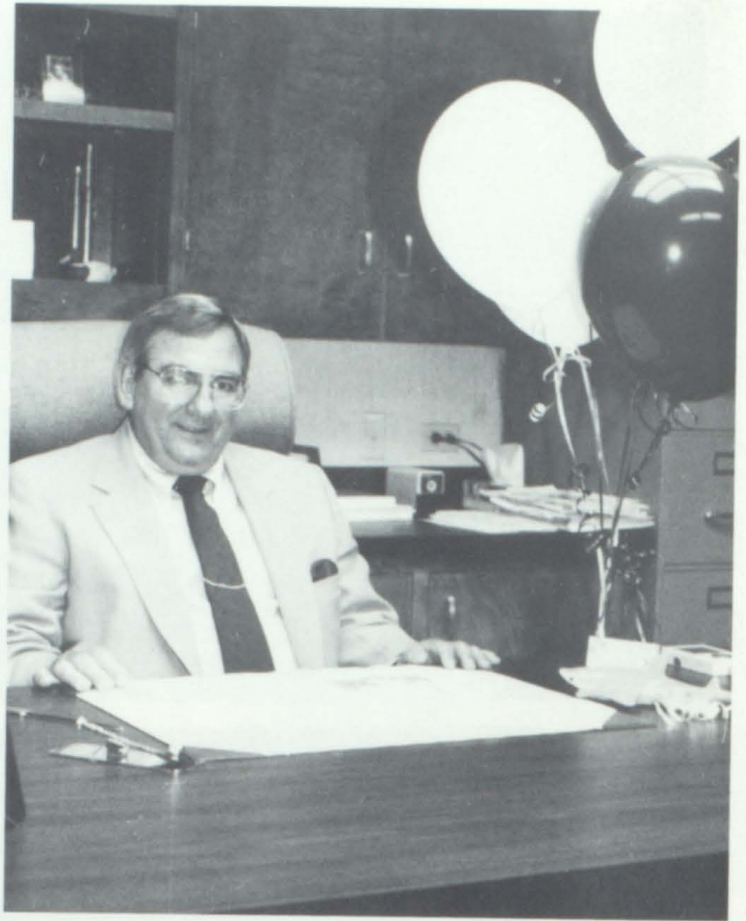

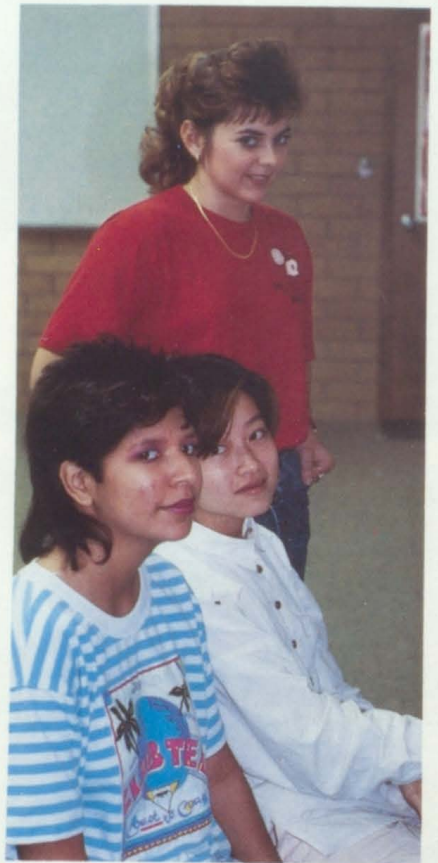

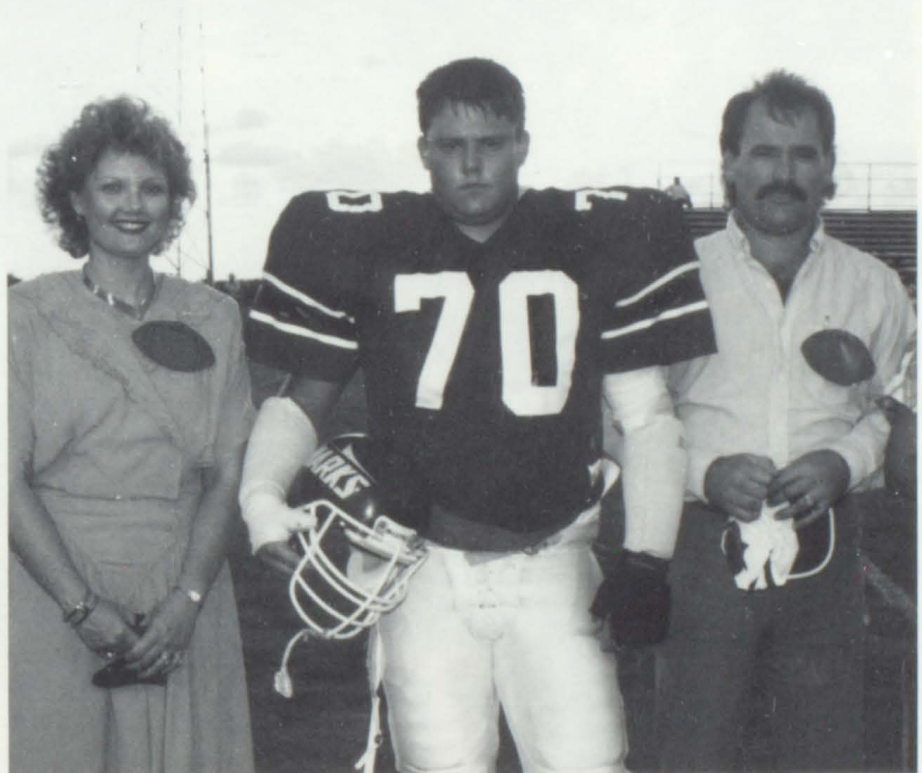

escort was Garrett Lenz.

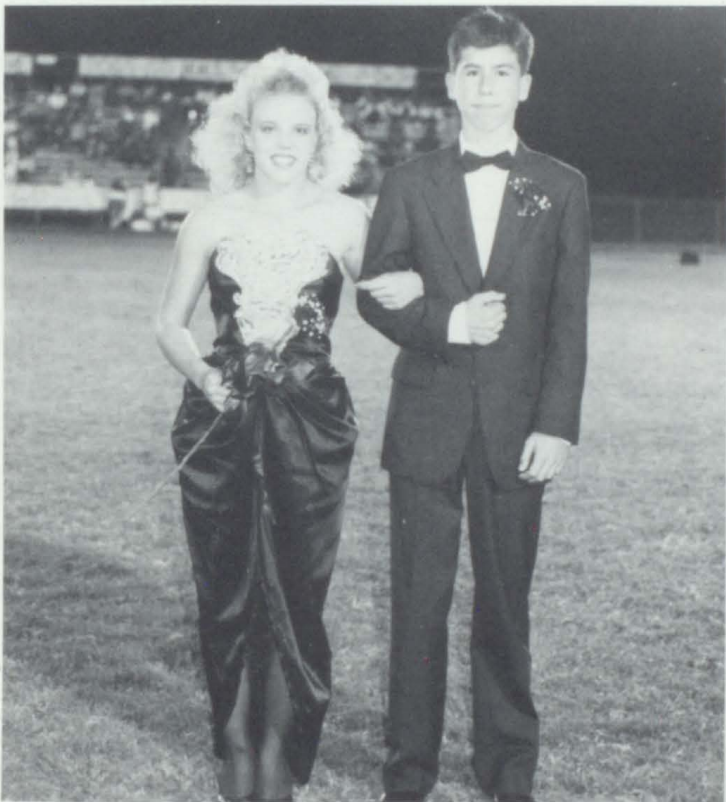
"I had a really good time. It was an experience I'll remember for the rest of my life," says Stephanie.
