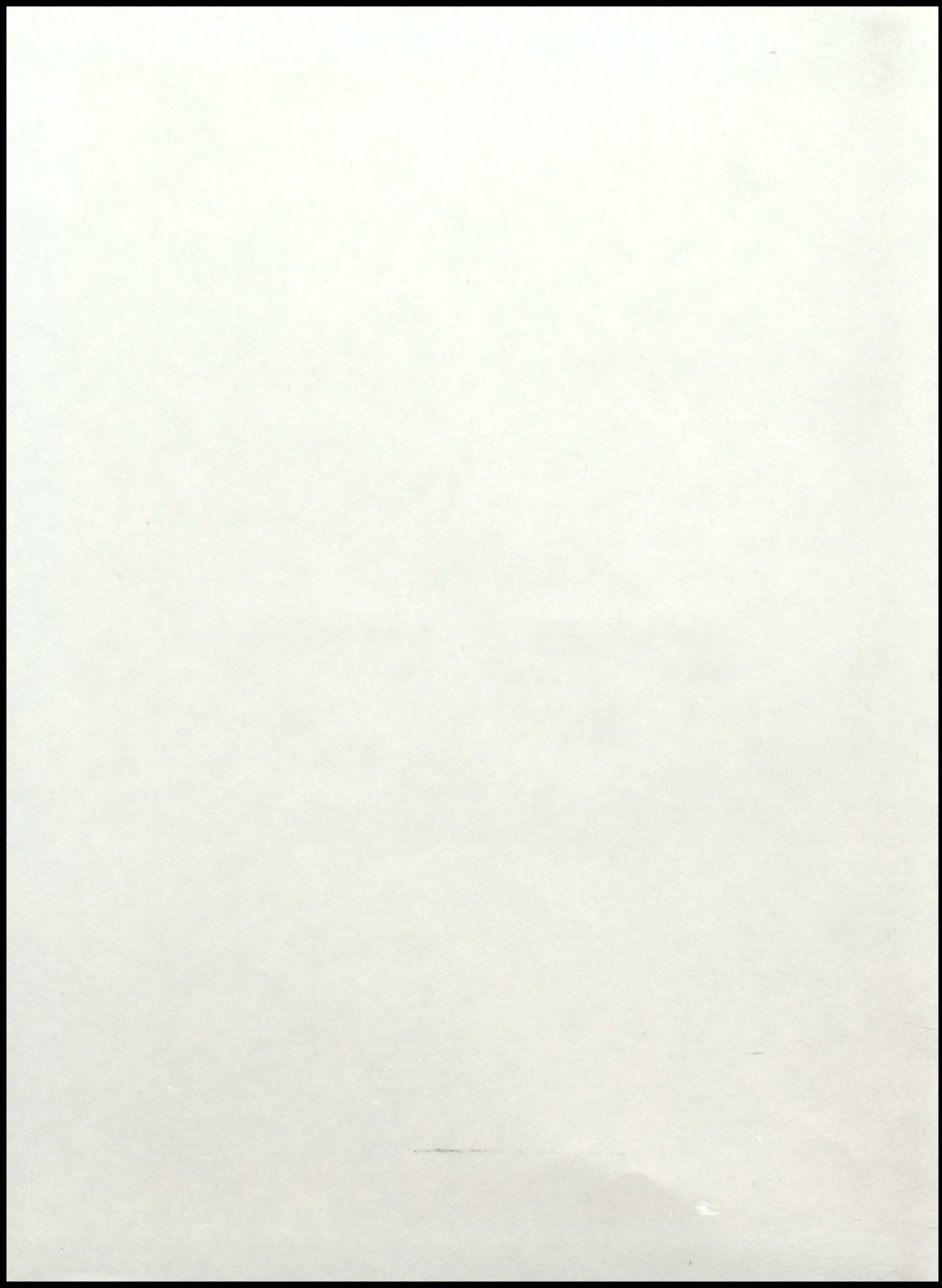

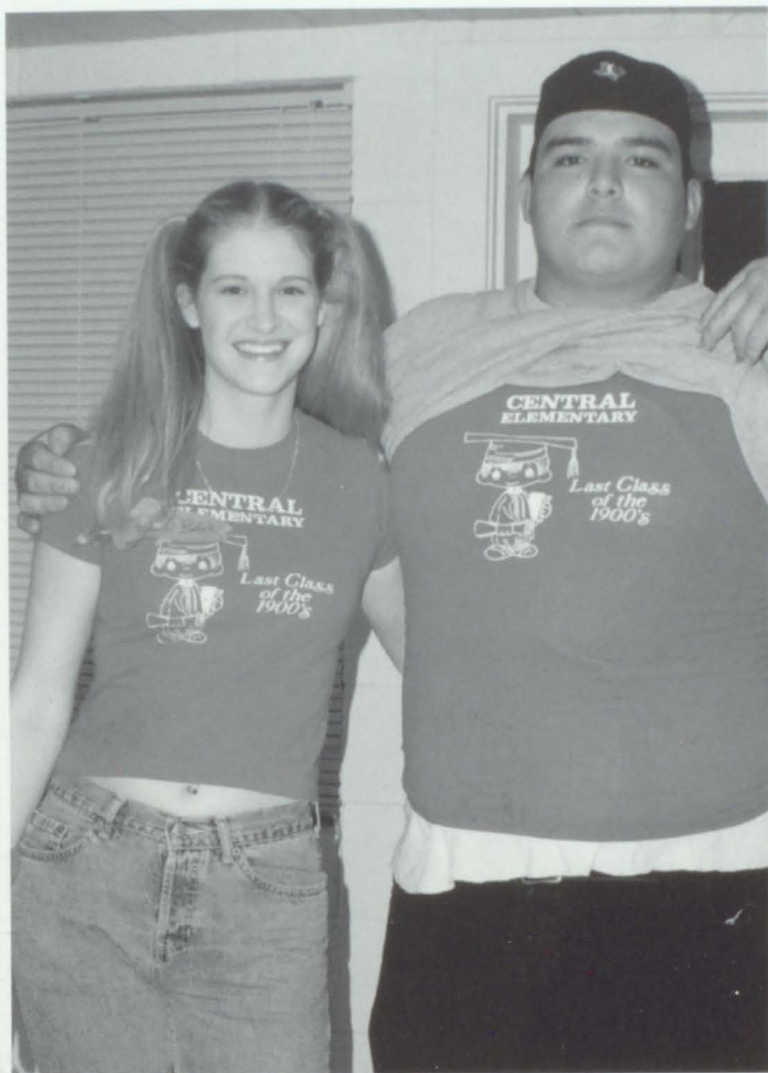

As the year comes to an end friends gather for a picture. It was a long year for these seniors; but, with a little bit of struggle and fun, they made it through.

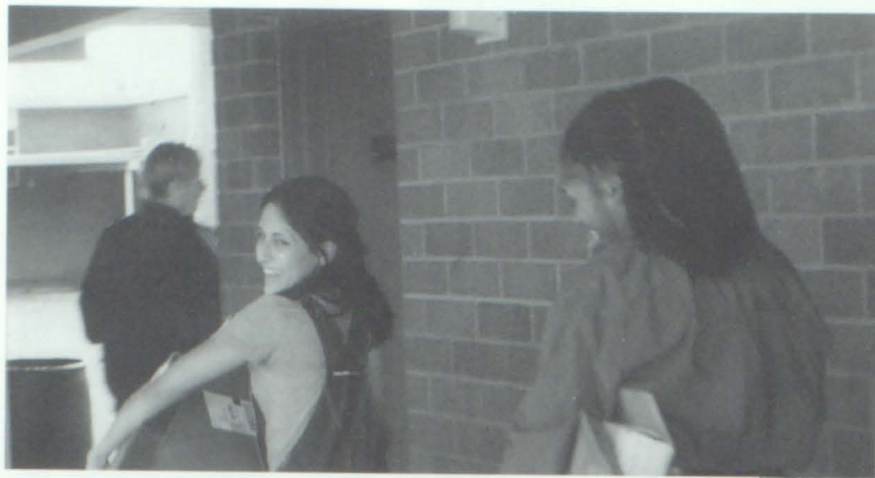

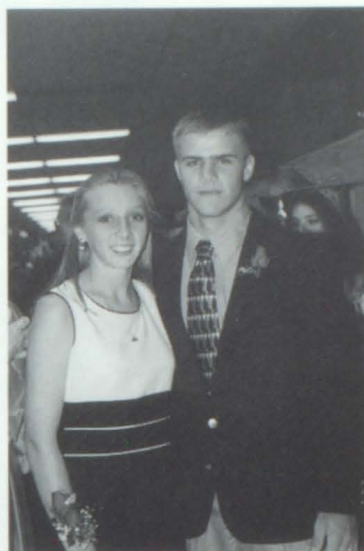

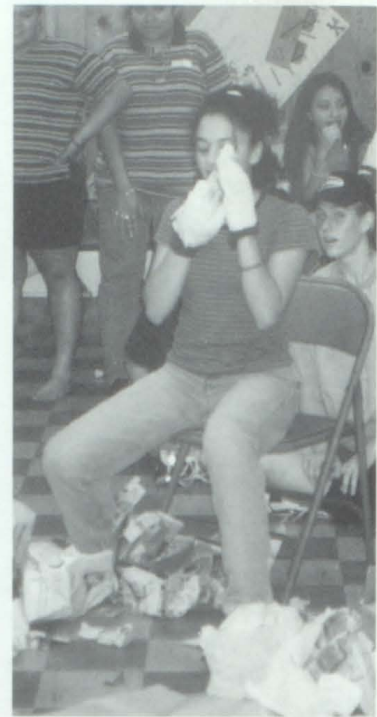


# Senior Parties

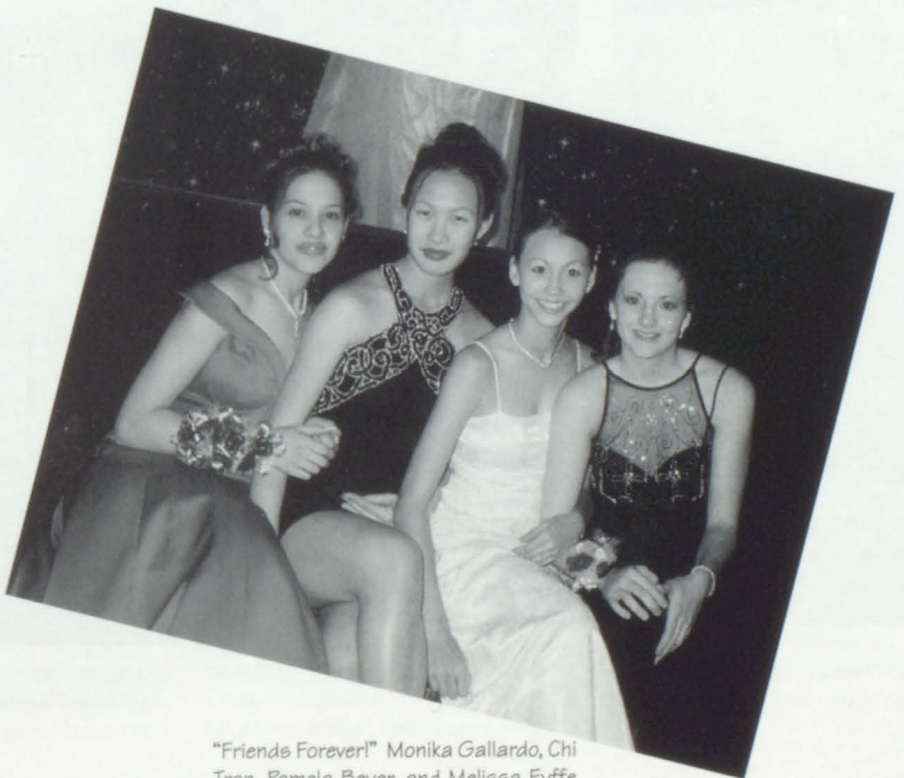

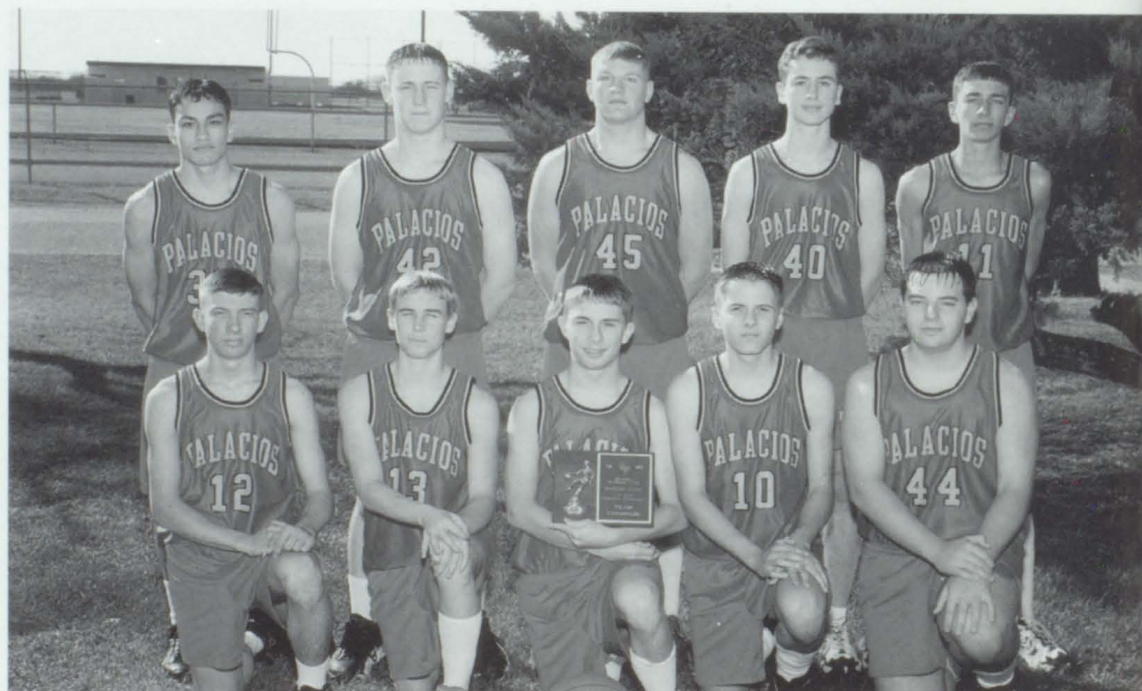

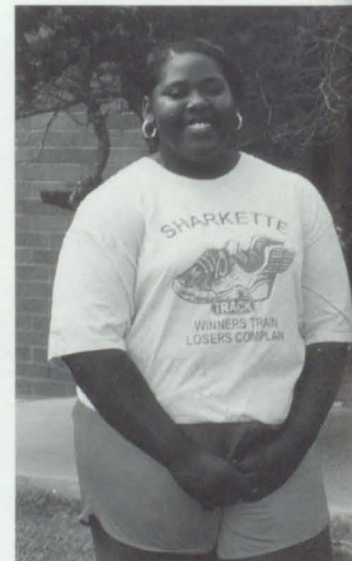

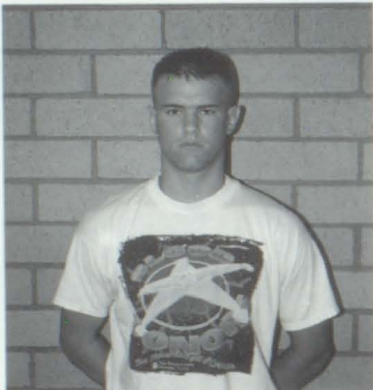

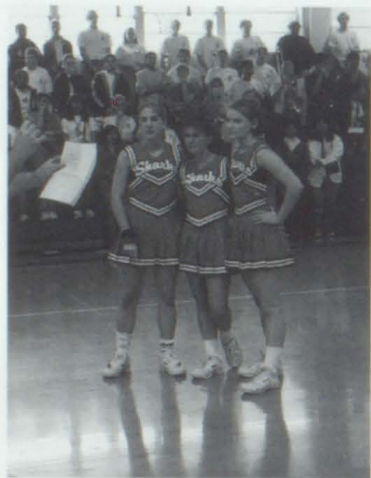

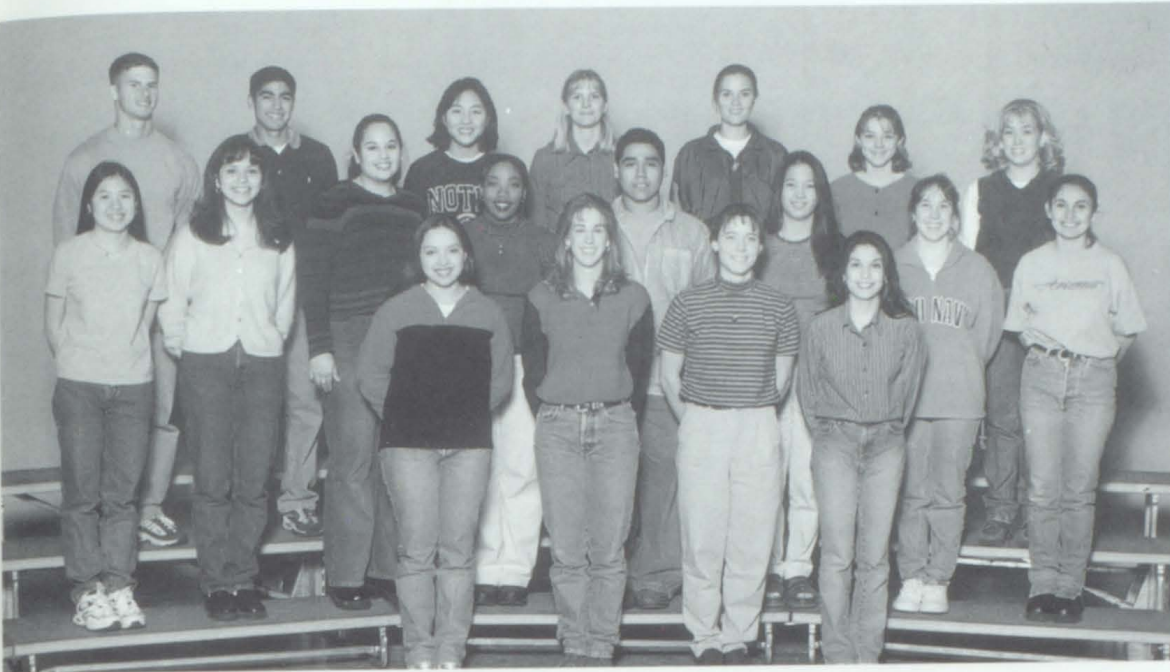

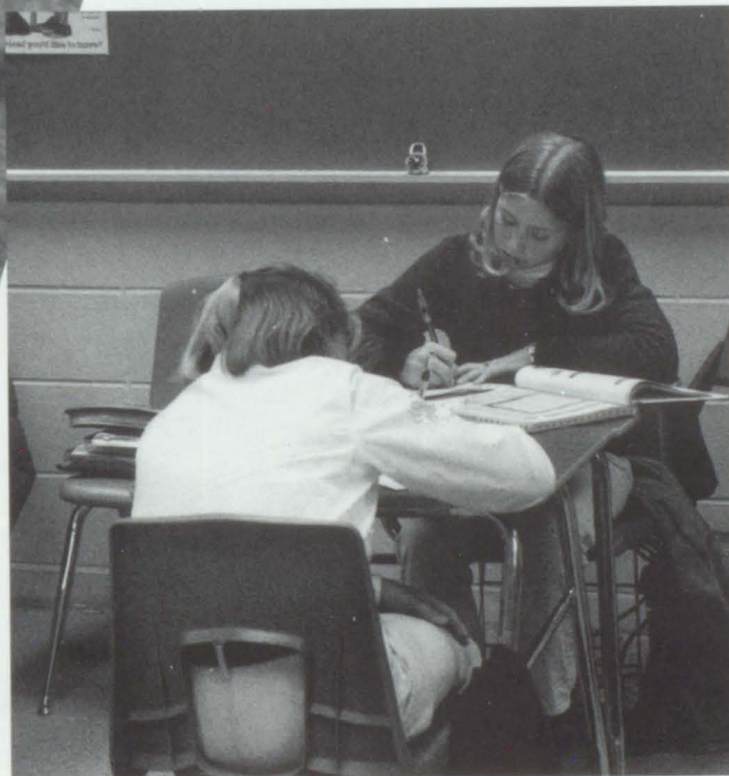


# Palacios Junior High
