


Even though all did not agree with some of the rules, such as cutting hair and wearing ropes for not having a belt, everyone accepted the rules with good humor. We were re-





The Junior class sponsors deserve a big thank you for all their time, help, and dedication toward making our prom successful.







Sinah and Alex became great friends while living in Palacios.






















Palacios Junior High
