the church for a meal of good old hotdogs and cokes and additional games.


This is what is all about. Martha Garcia and Dulce Nunez have a good time at the hobo party and share past memories.

Angela Farmer, Stephani Aoughsten, and Cathy Garza cherish their night at the Prom. This group of girls have been friends for years and now they prepare to part.





The highlight of the evening was when the Prom King and Queen were announced. This year's honor went to Brandon Bowers and Daphni Seaman.









Jason Brinkley, a first place ranking powerlifter in some powerlifting competitions, works every day during the season to improve his lifts. What might seem strenuous to normal athletes


is easily mastered by those on the powerlifting team. Although Jason was injured through a good portion of the season, he still managed to make it to the state competition.
















