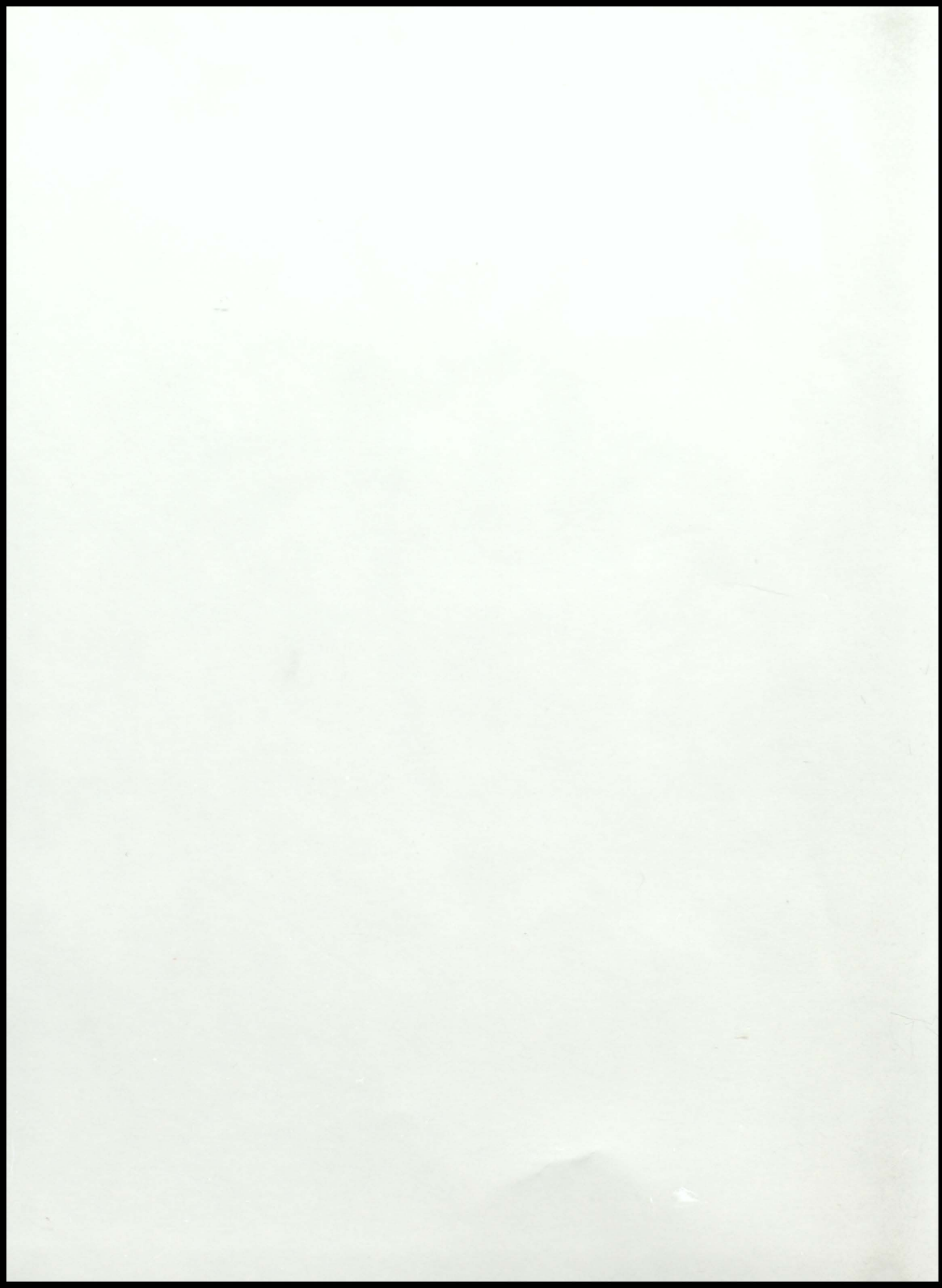

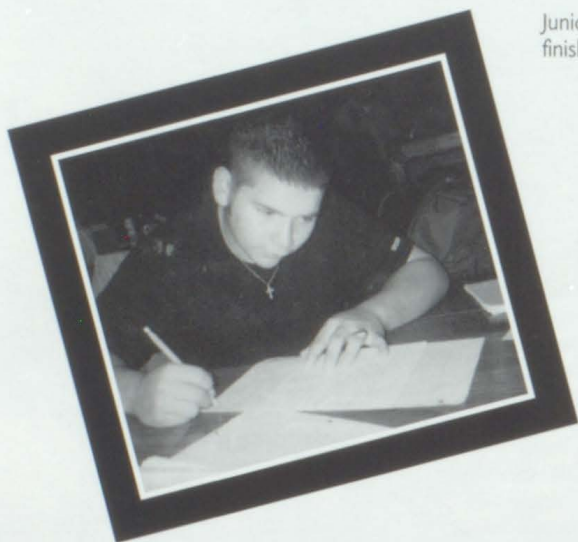


# Student Life: The Good Life

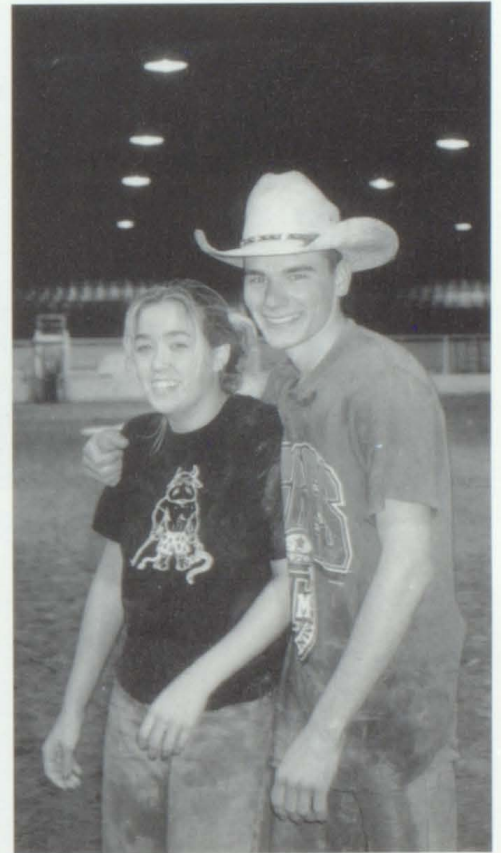

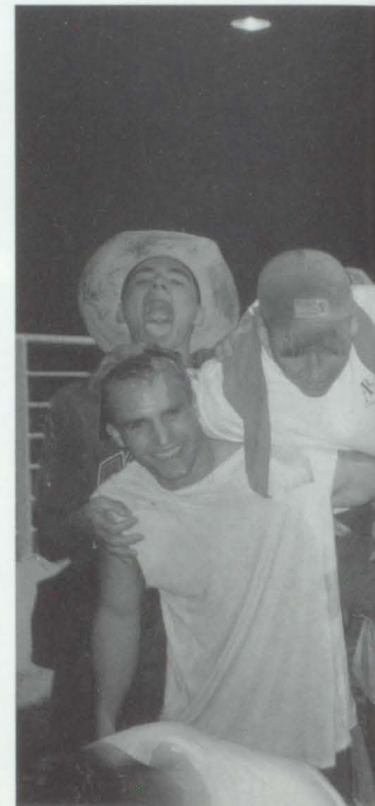

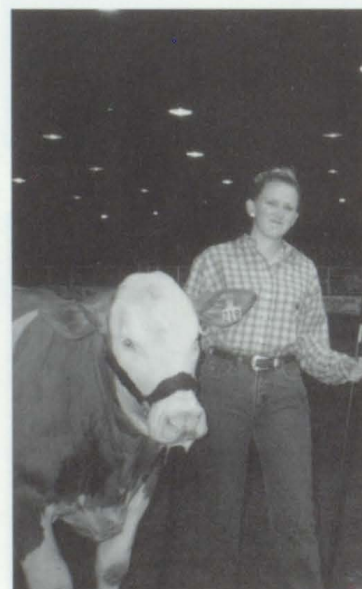

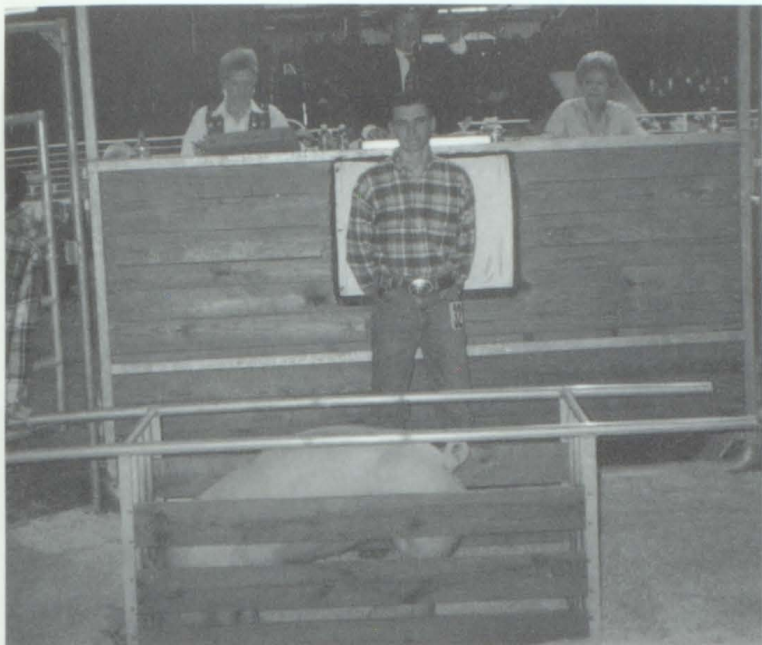

# "A Night of Enchantment"

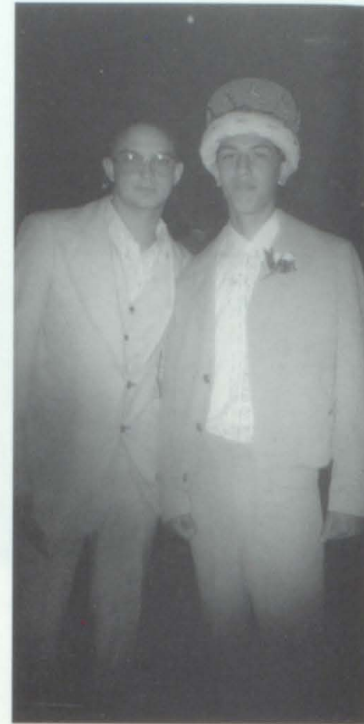
This year the Junior-Senior Prom was held on April 21. The Juniors did a great job decorating. There was a beautiful castle for the background and all of the decorations were perfect.

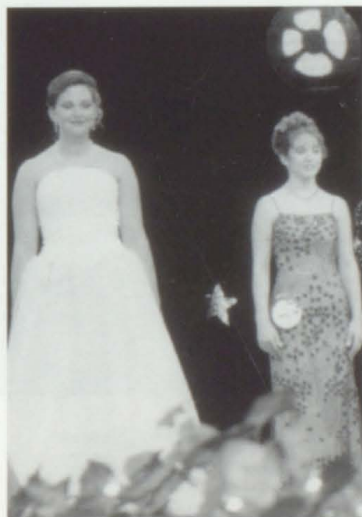

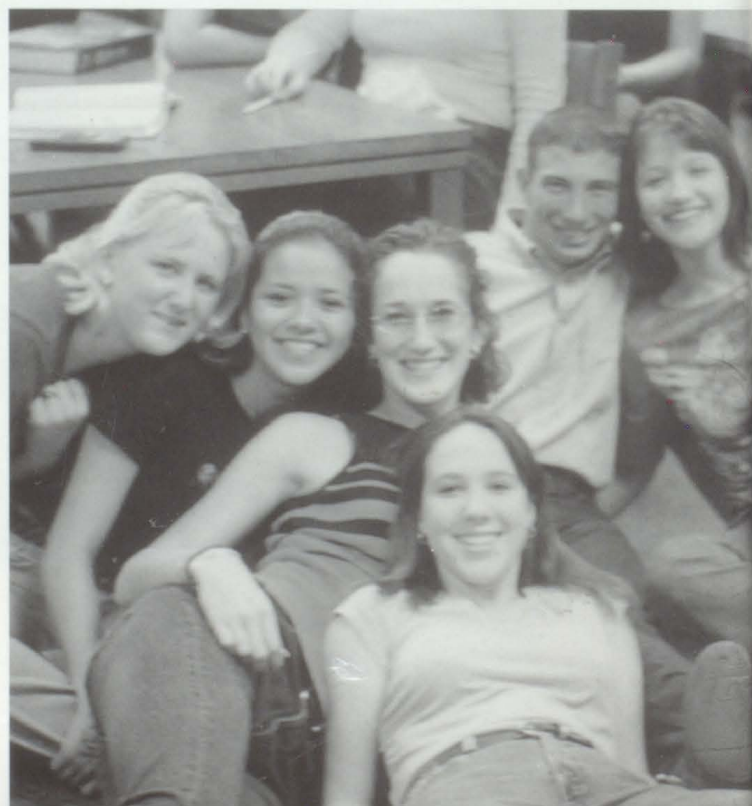
# People: Life of the Party

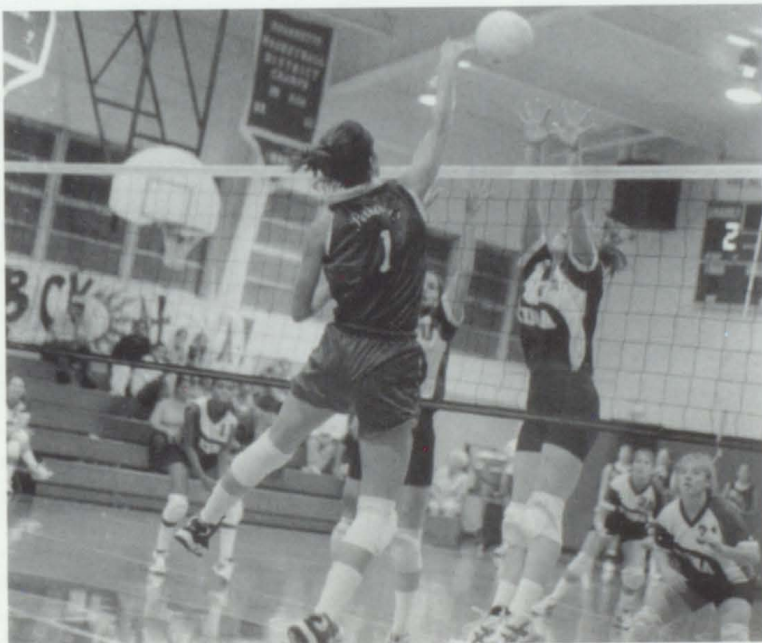

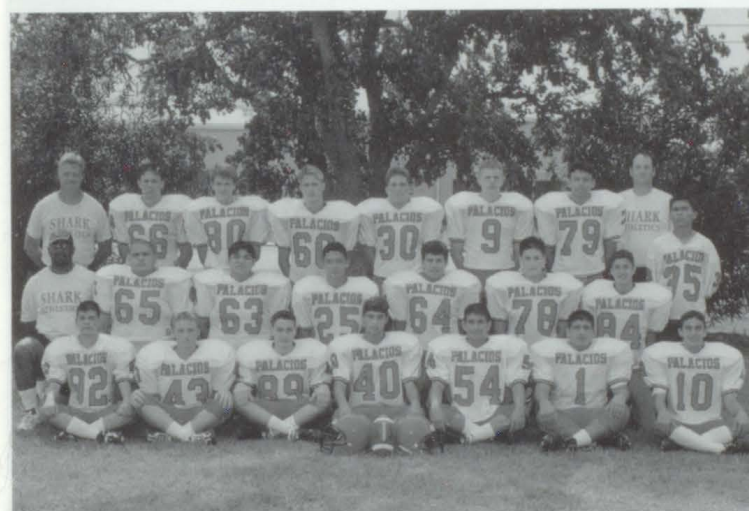

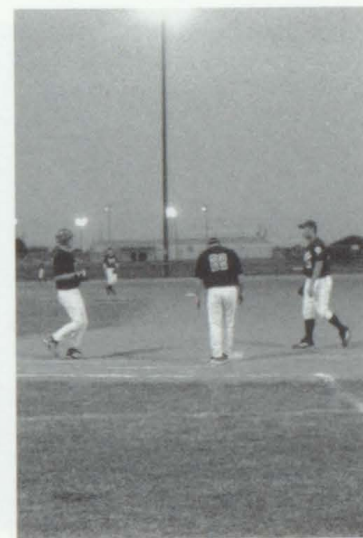

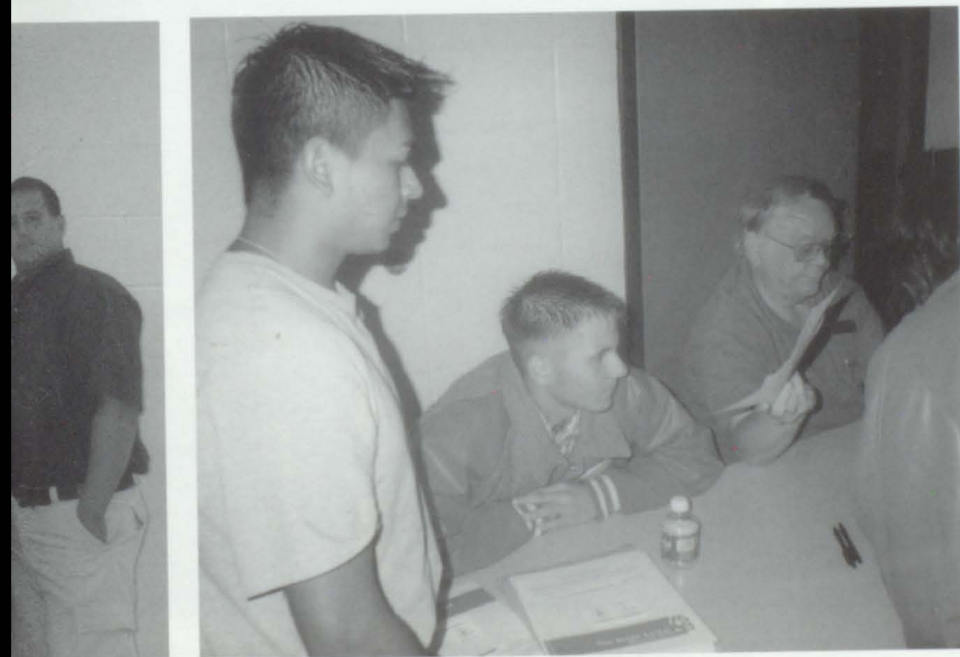

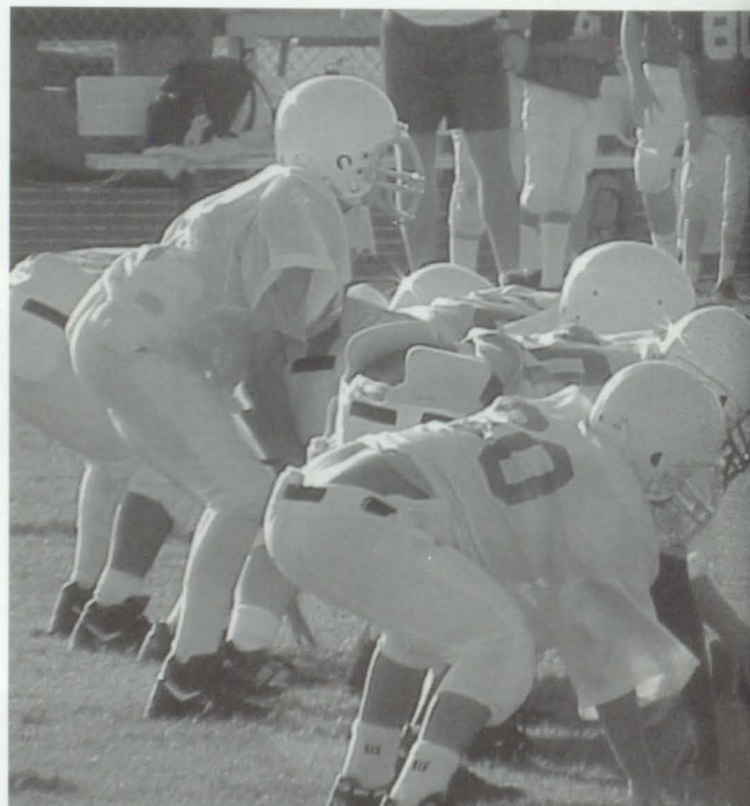
