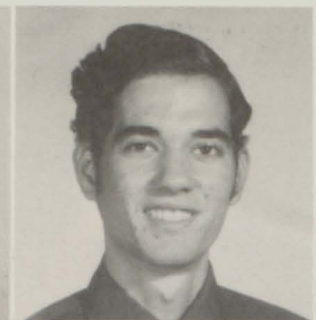

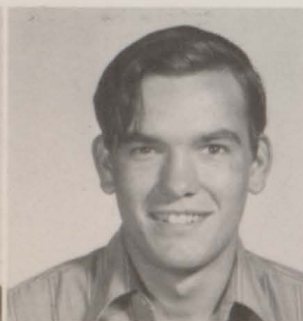

One day as you flip through the pages of this edition of the Tiger, we hope it will bring back the many cherished memories that were so important to you during your years at Tidehaven.

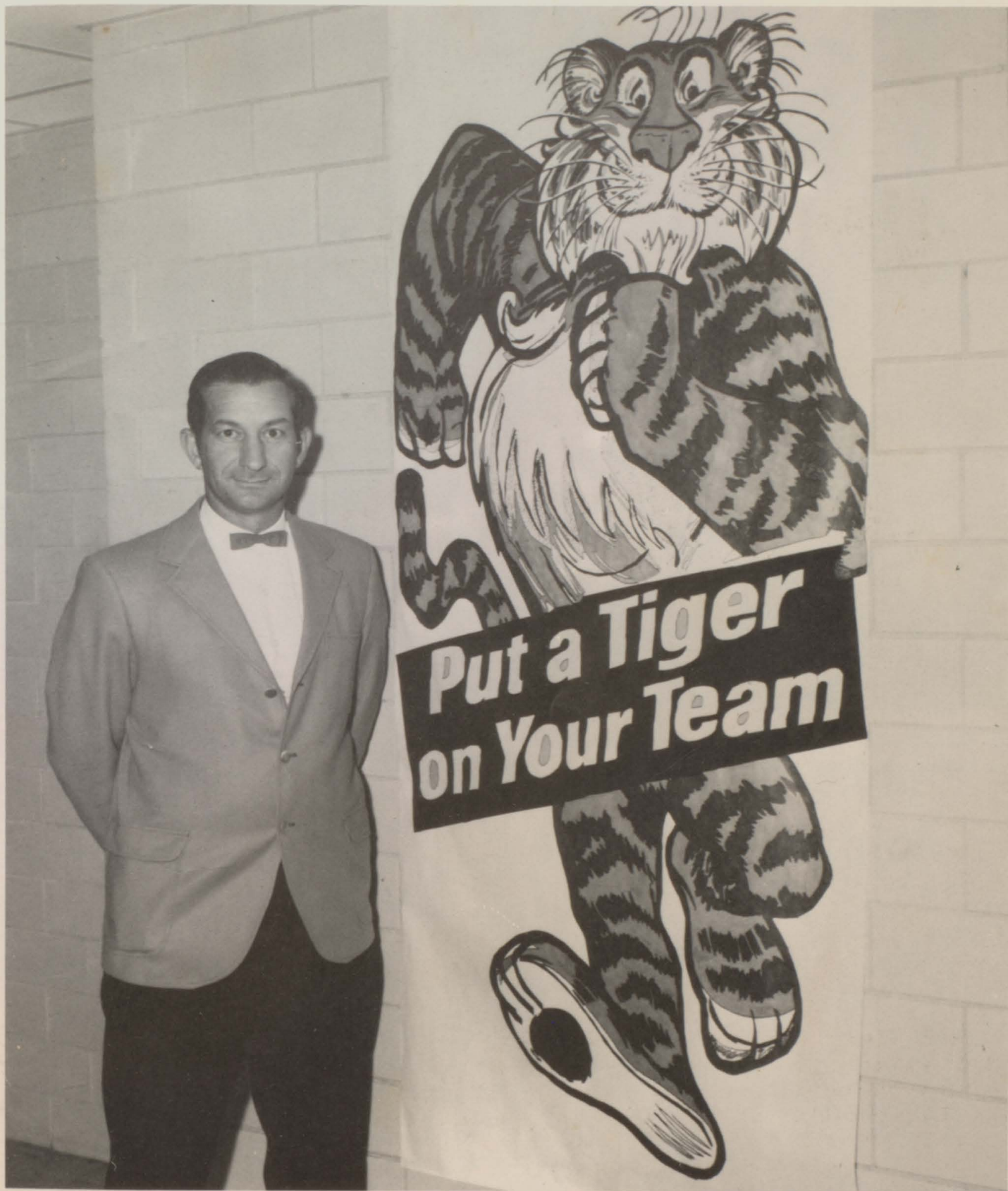
