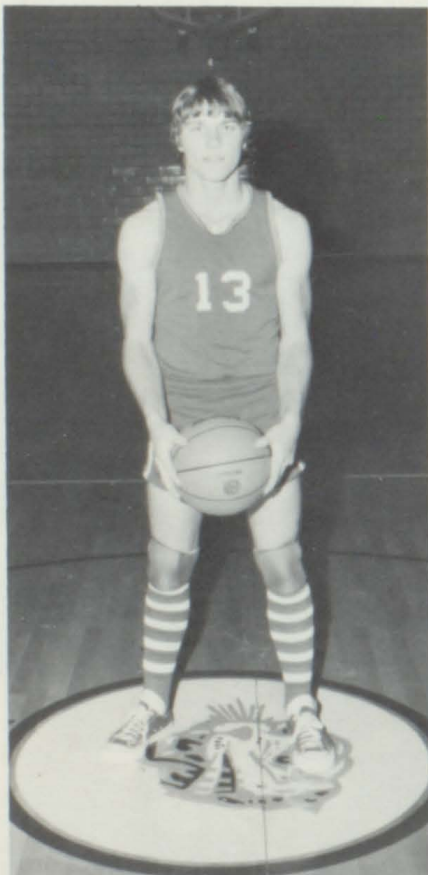


The Tidehaven Tiger Varsity Basketball Squad had a season record of 13 wins and 15 losses and a district record of 6 wins and 8 losses.
