The band worked hard preparing the music and drill for marching contest and was disappointed in the III rating the judges gave them.


In October, the band participated in the University of Houston Band Night at the Astrodome. Here, they performed with the

A Christmas Concert was held on December 20 at Markham Elementary. The program consisted of a number of wellknown Christmas carols.

















The Tidehaven Tiger Varsity Basketball Squad had a season record of 13 wins and 15 losses and a district record of 6 wins and 8 losses.


