From Shipping Goods to Shipping Students



TIDEHAVEN HIGH SCHOOL

The Tidehaven High School is located on land that once adjoined the old port of Tidehaven. The port was at one time the loading dock for river steamers. Though hides, tallow, cattle, and other goods were once shipped across the Tidehaven wharves, its past has become forgotten. All of the shipping took place during the Civil War period.

The High School is about two or three miles from the old Tidehaven landing which is just off Farm to Market 1095 between Highway 35 and the Tidehaven Jr. High.

In 1948 there were plans to consolidate the Blessing and Markham schools. On July 17, 1948 the people voted for the consolidation. In the fall of 1950, the school was opened.

The Tidehaven School District is approximately 293 square miles in area, about two fifths the size of the state of Rhode Island.

The words to the Tidehaven Alma Mater were written by Mr. James Pennington. The music is *Finlandia*.

The school mascot, Alfred the Tiger, was named after Alfred Hansen, Markham Superintendent and Tidehaven Business Manager, who died in August of 1951. He was a great supporter of athletics.
