Stepping in, we see Marty and Jennifer Crain off in a secluded corner sipping wine and reminiscing about "old times and sharing".

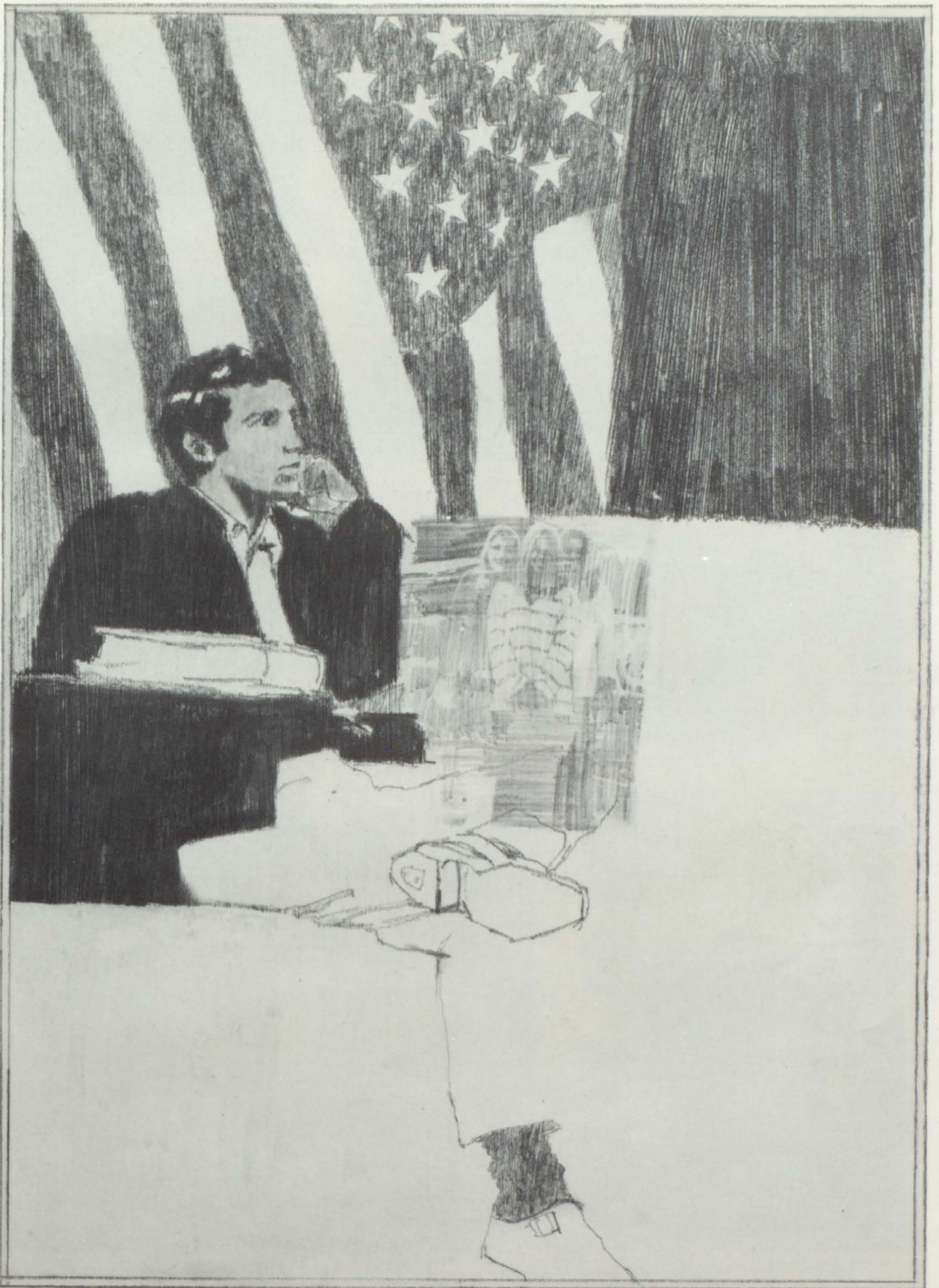

For the Christmas Concert held on December 18 we played traditional Christmas carols and had a visit from Santa.

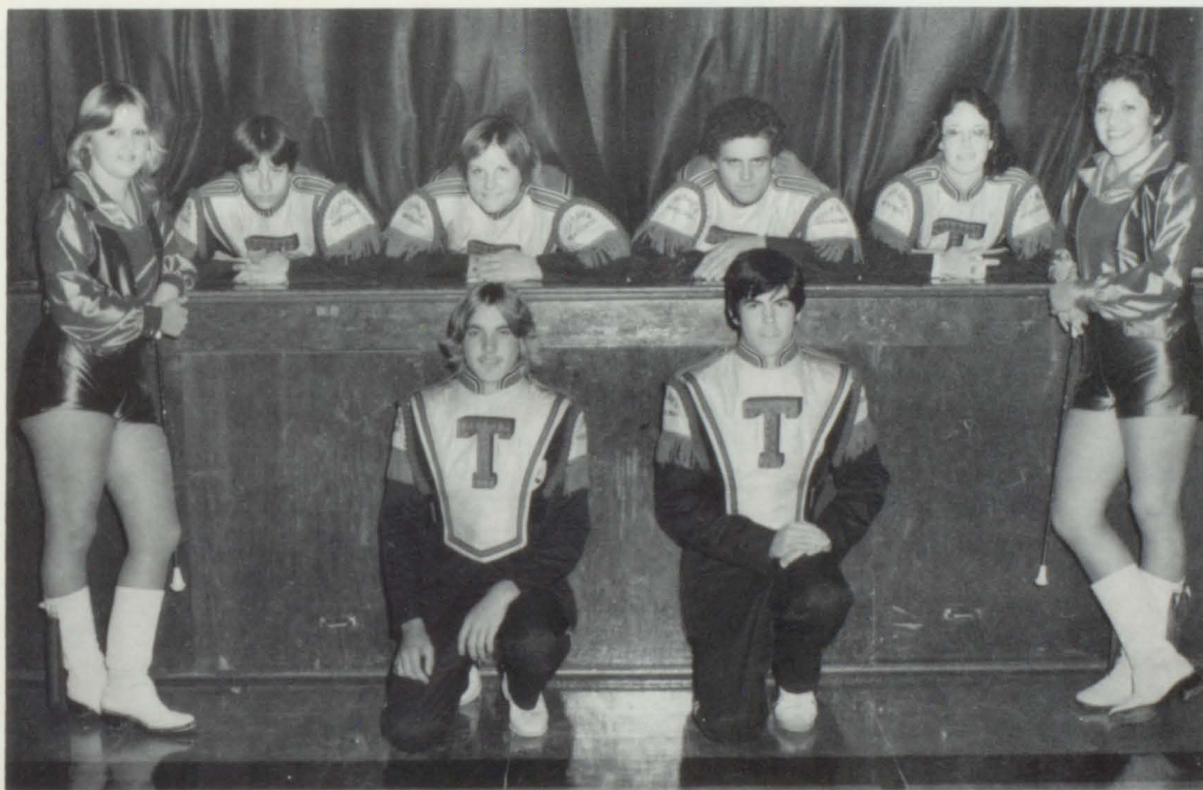
