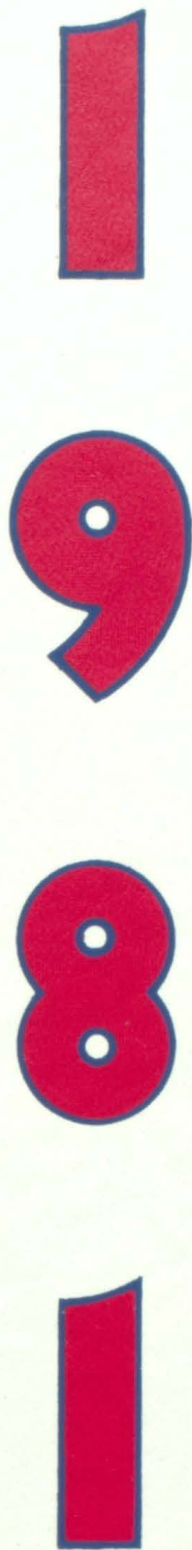

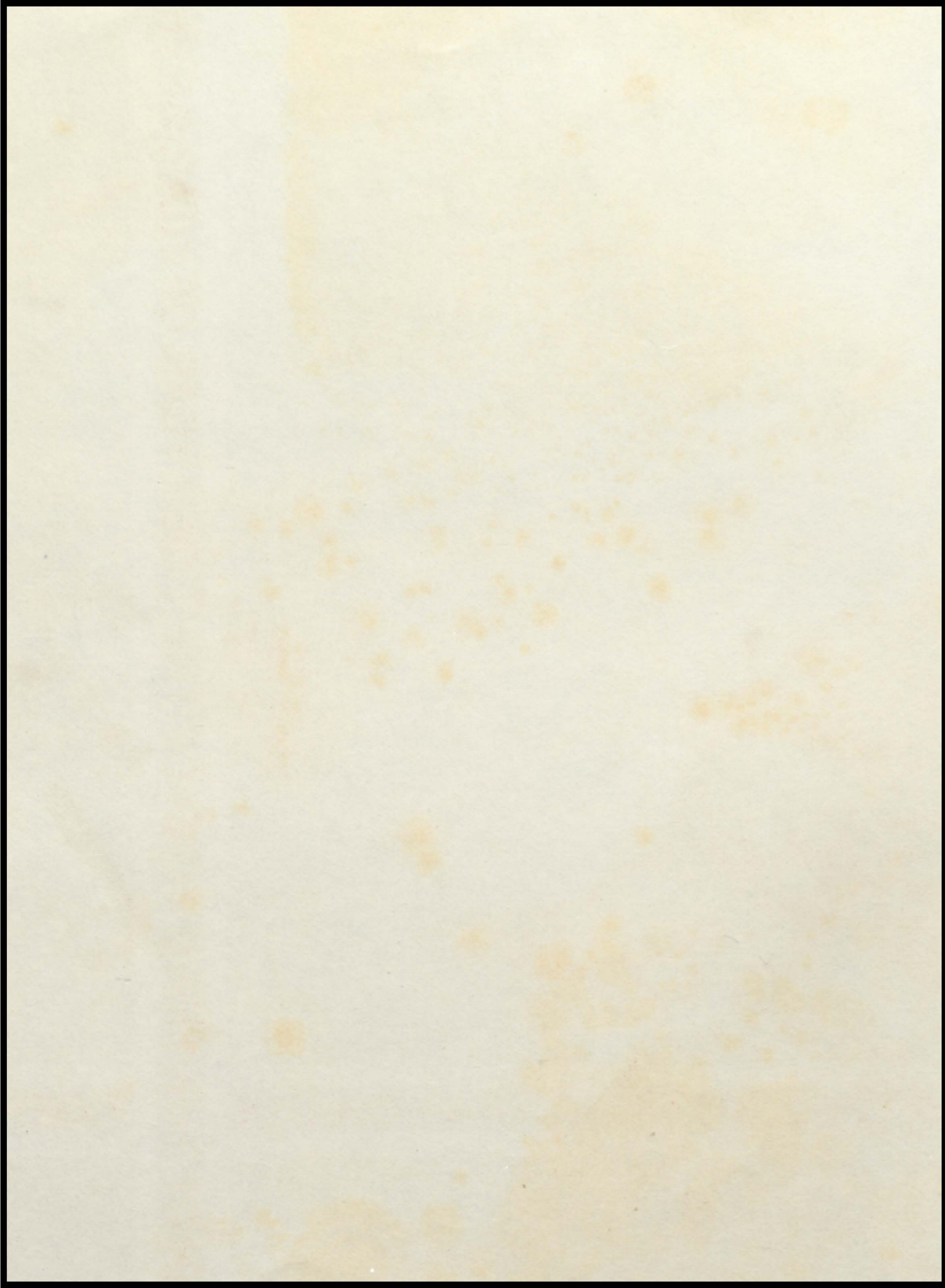

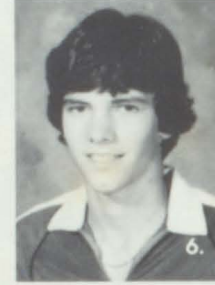

The annual staff of 1980-81 wishes to dedicate this edition of *The Tiger* to a person we all turn to for advice and leadership, Mr. J. O. Baker.

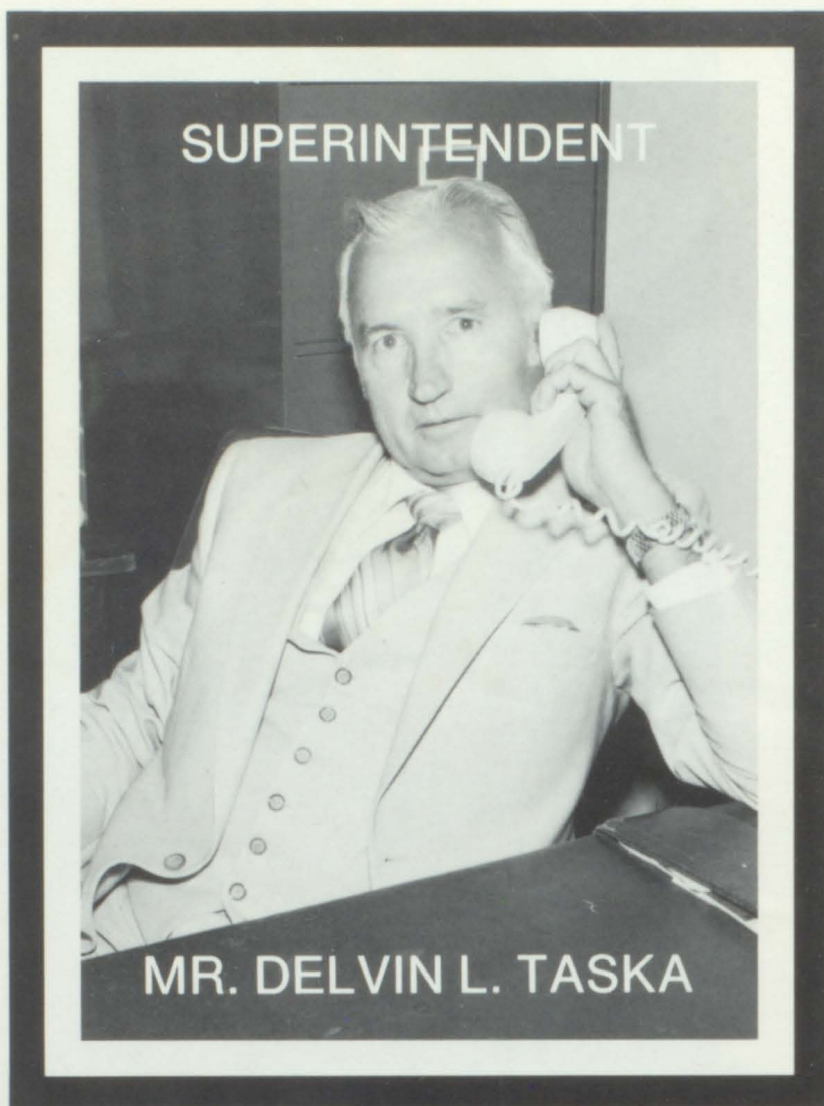
It is because of the significant part in the growth of Tidehaven and its students he plays that we would like to honor him with this year's annual.

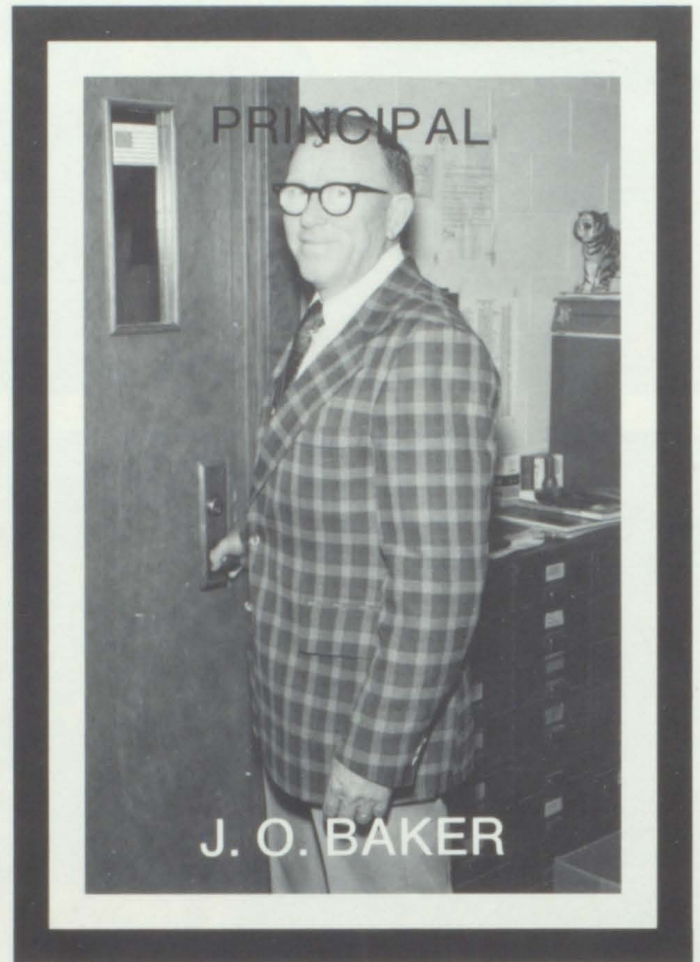
A MESSAGE TO STUDENTS

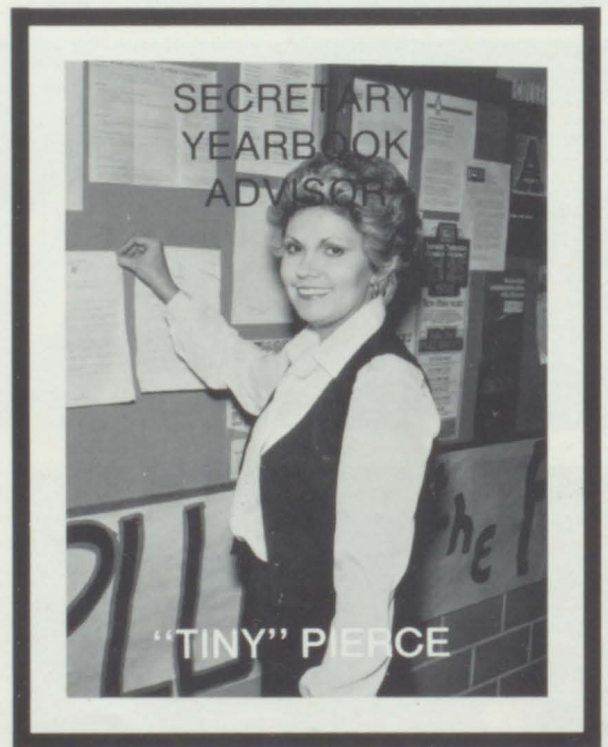

TIDEHAVEN WELCOMES "8" NEW TEACHERS

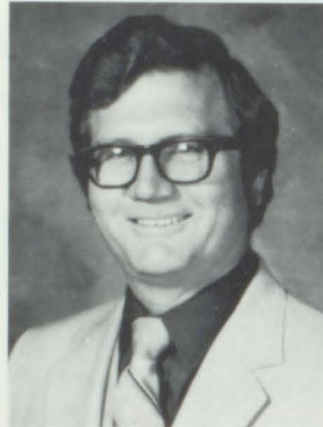

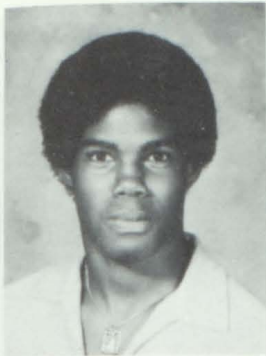
JUNIORS RELAX AFTER BUSY YEAR
