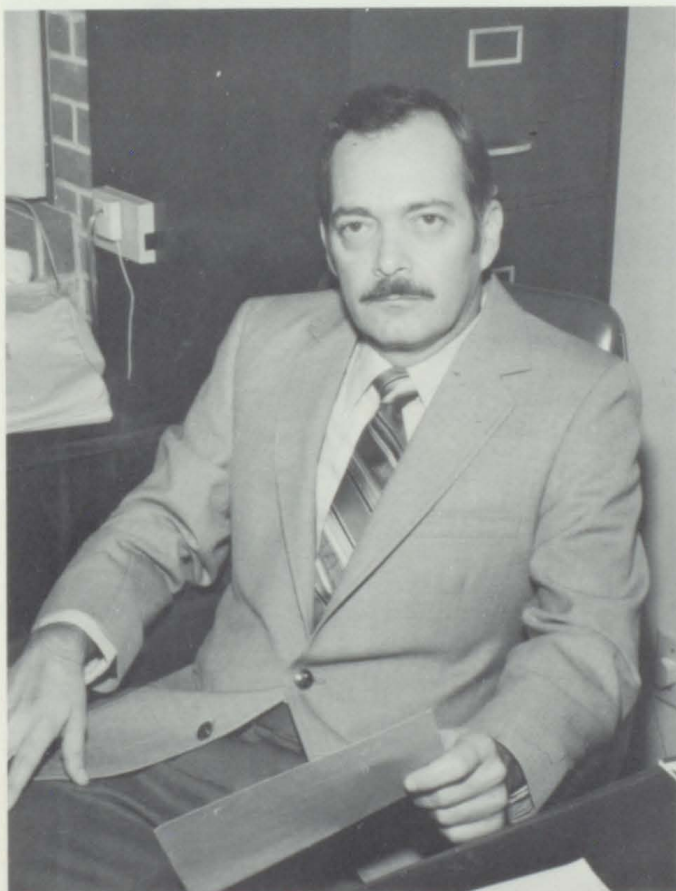




## Superintendent

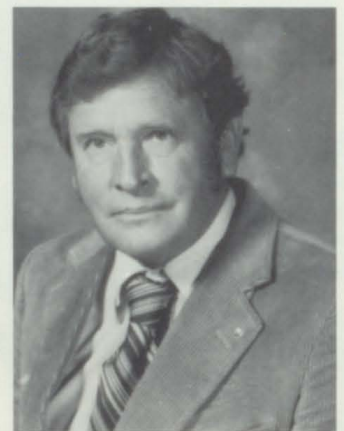
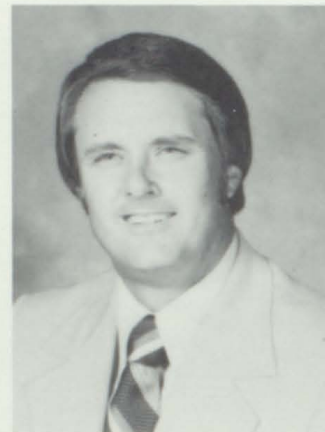
# Add and Subtract

They also did very well at the County Fair receiving a rosette won by Liza Gomez, 22 blue, 13 red and 7 white ribbons.



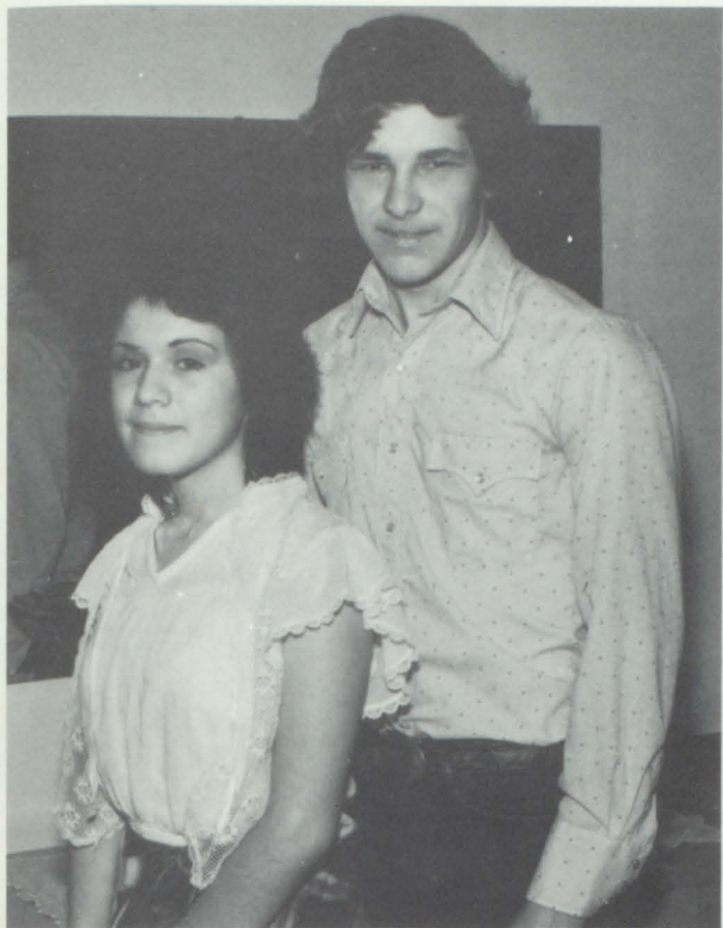
