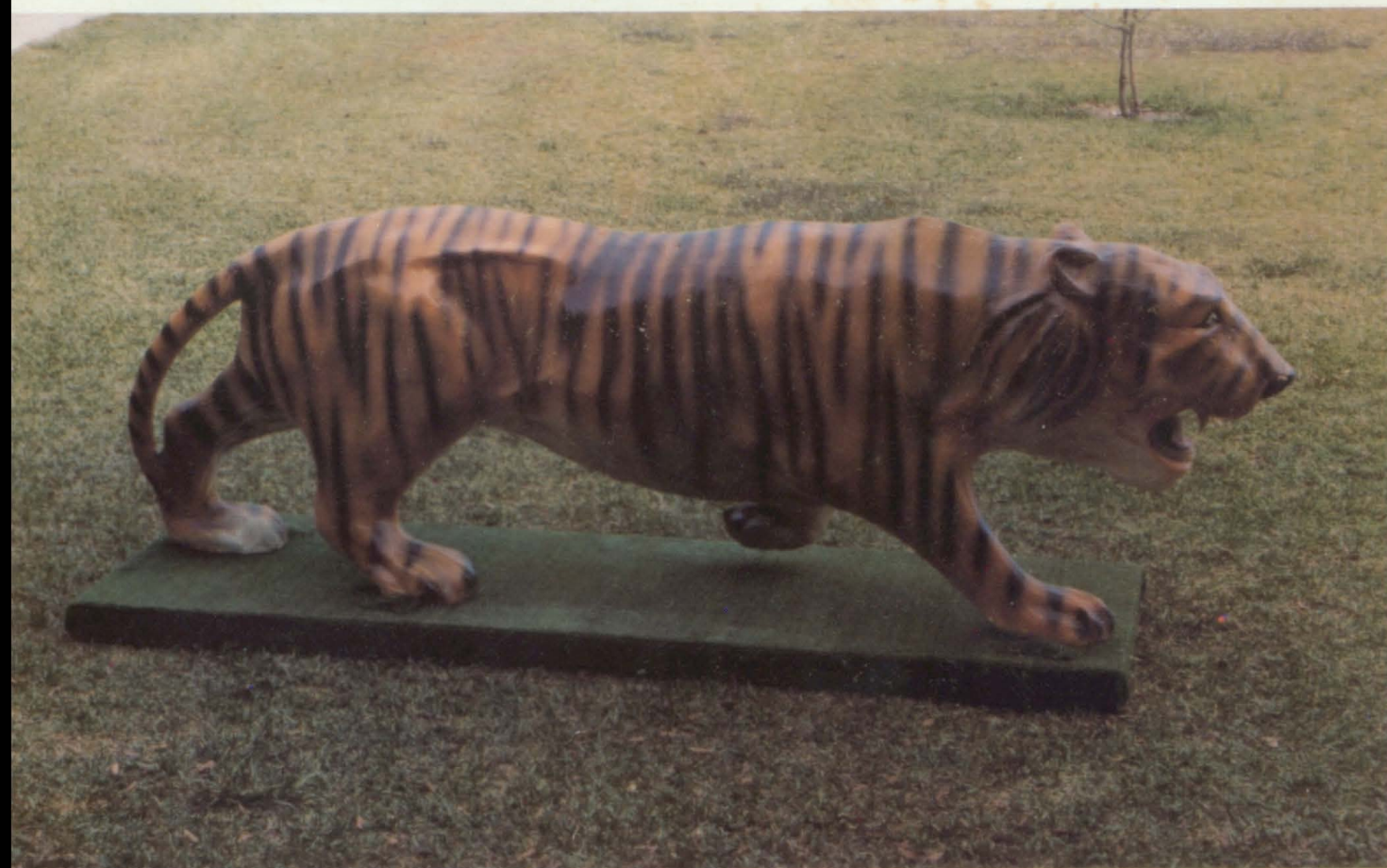


Rising up back on the street

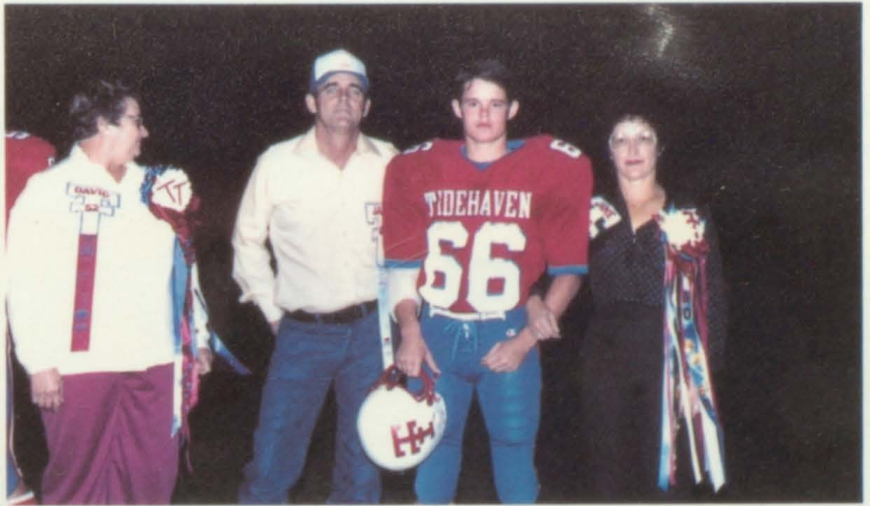

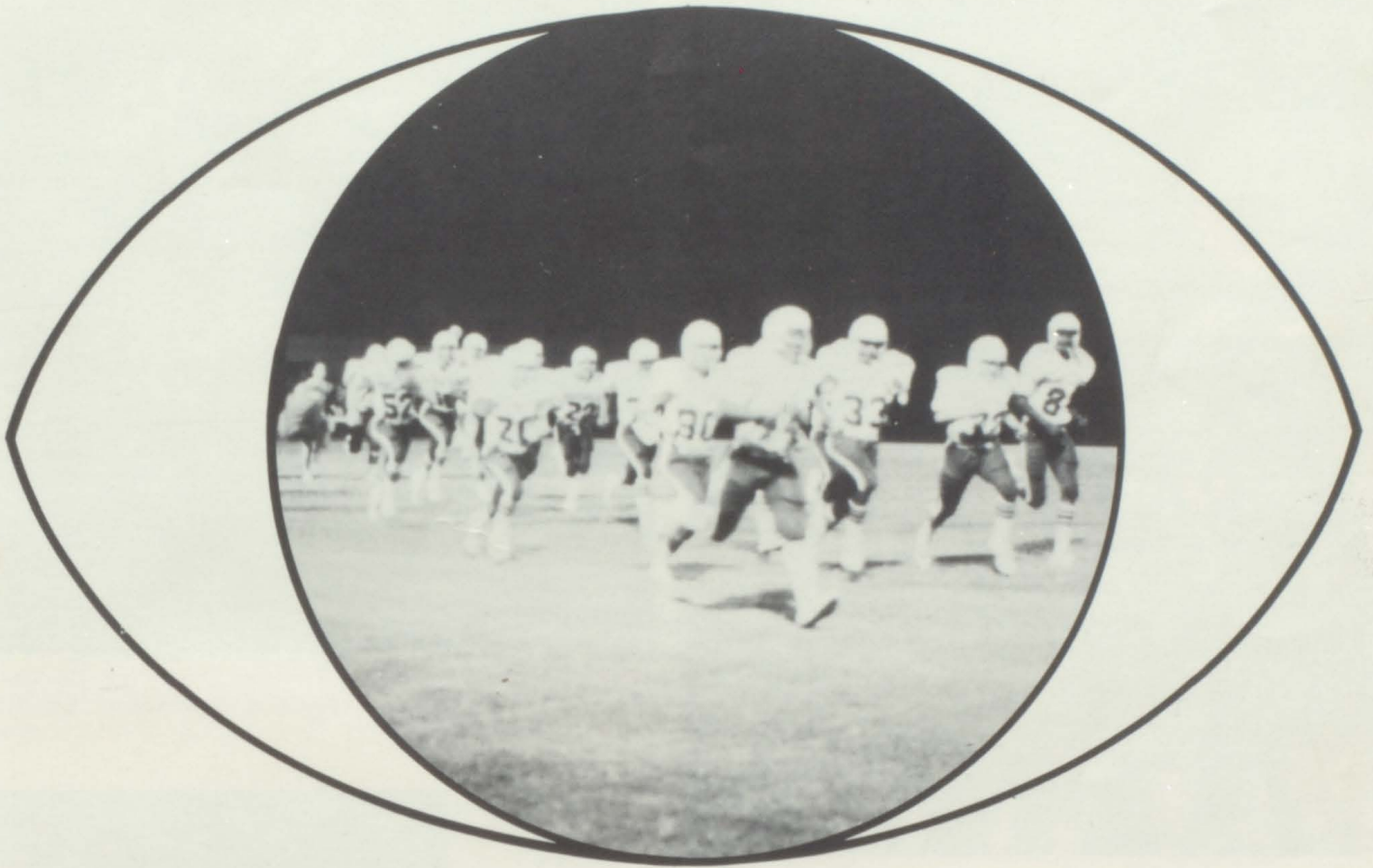

"We can do it, yes we can, come on TIGERS, WIN! WIN! WIN!

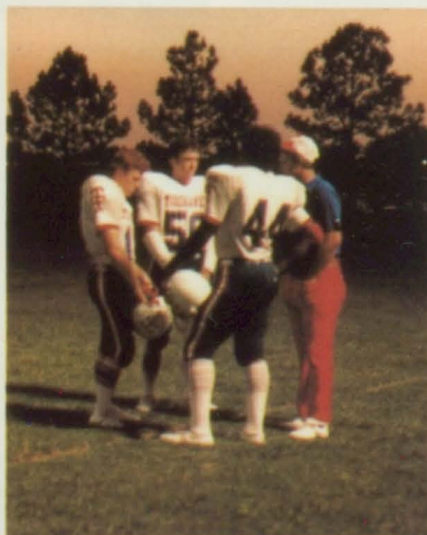
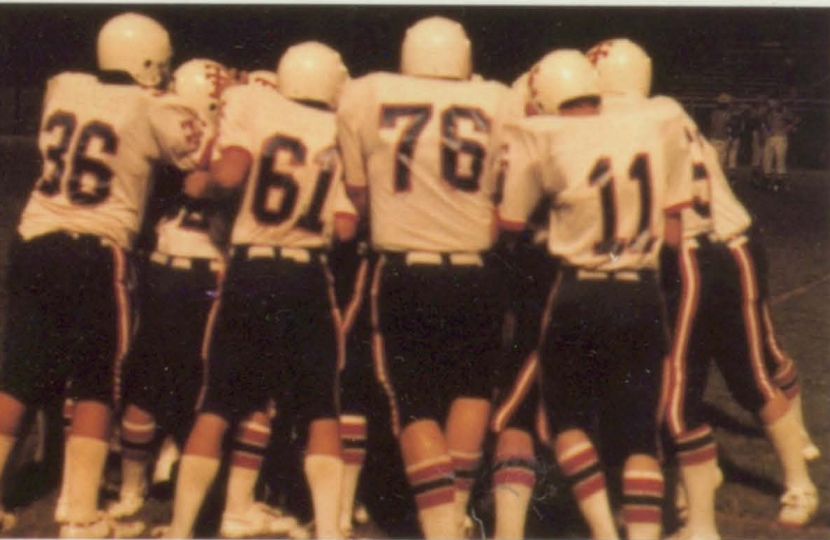
