

Hadden Wins State 400 Meter Run

For two eyars, Darrell Hadden has been trying to beat Royce Avery of Woodsboro High School in the 400 Meter Dash. Last year he came up short, placing 2nd behind Avery at the state meet.

Not This Year, Though!

Darrell beat two-time state champion Avery to take first place in the 400 meter dash at the boy's state track meet May 12th.

Darrell, running in lane 2, took the lead in the first 100 yds. and maintained this lead throughout the race. At the finish line he was 6 yds. ahead of his nearest competitor, a trackster from Pottsboro.

"I was thinking about winning it and beating him," Hadden said after he crossed the finish line in 47.5 for first place, two places ahead of Avery. "It was the last 110 yards that did it."

Darrell was only .3 second behind the state record of 47.2 set by another Tidehaven trackster — Ira Gordon — in 1968.

The spring activities included selling valentines to raise money for the Heart Fund and attending the State Convention in Austin, where Dena Neuman and Robin McMillan served as delegates.



7 members, including Liza Gomez — Area III Treas., attended the Area III meeting in Houston. 4 members attended the state meeting in San Antonio.


