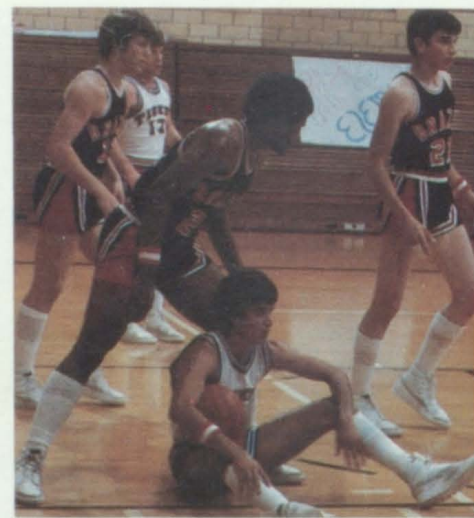


New Style

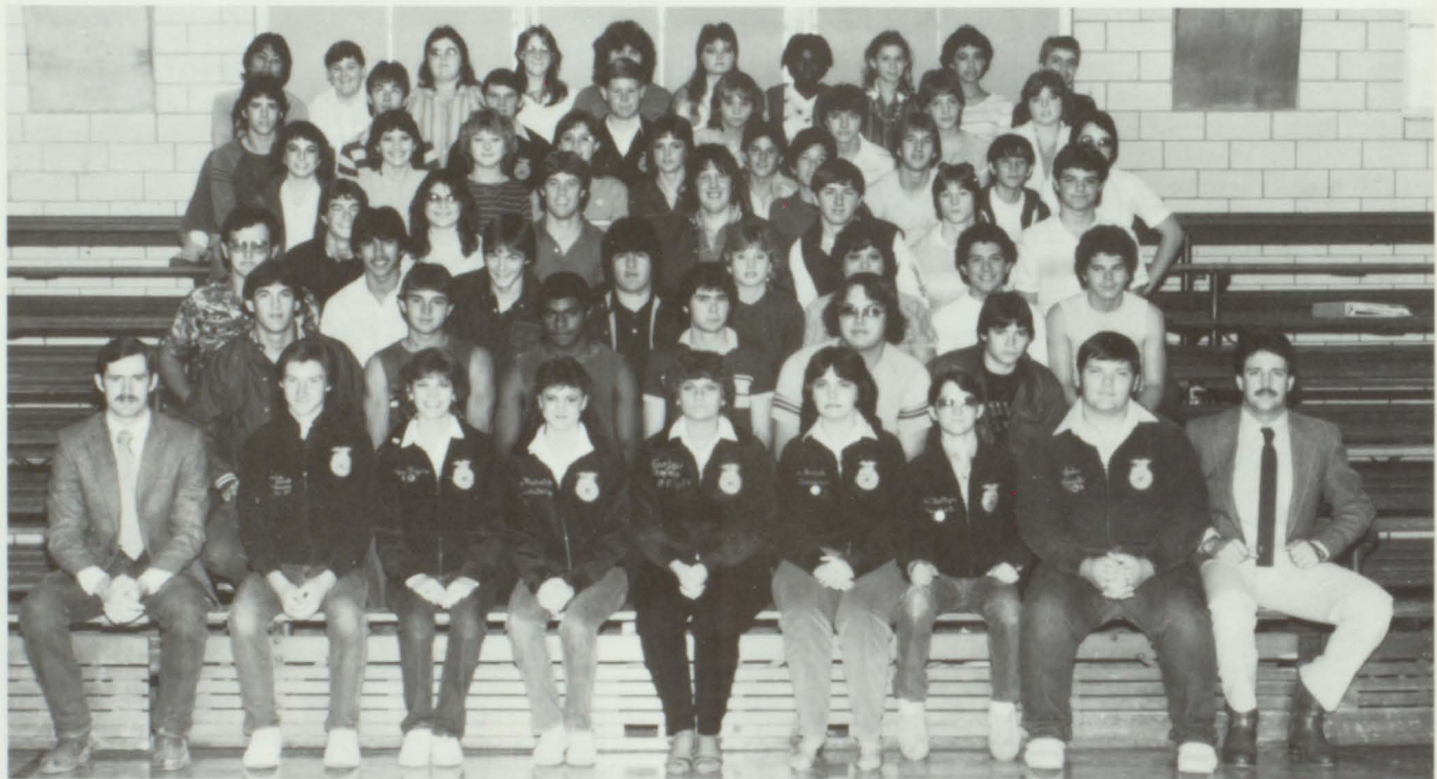
The future of our country lies in the hands of our youth. The F.F.A. is a youth organization that is doing its part to prepare for the future.
