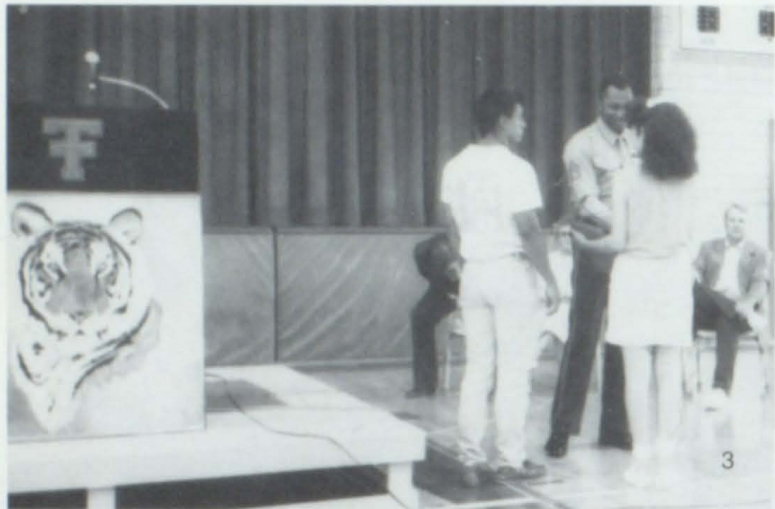

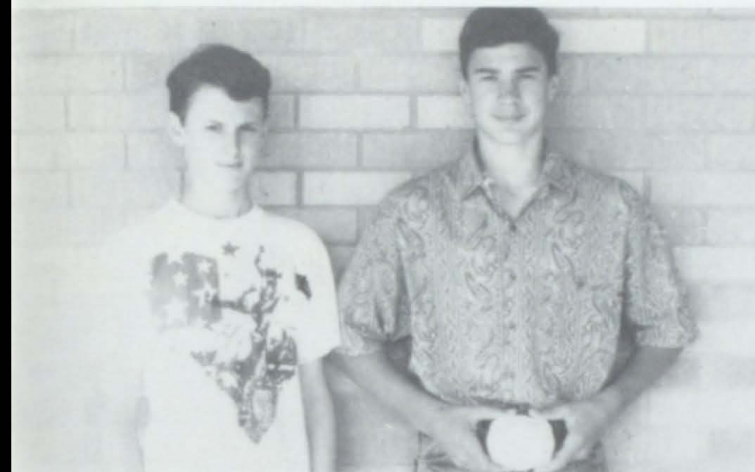


FFA
