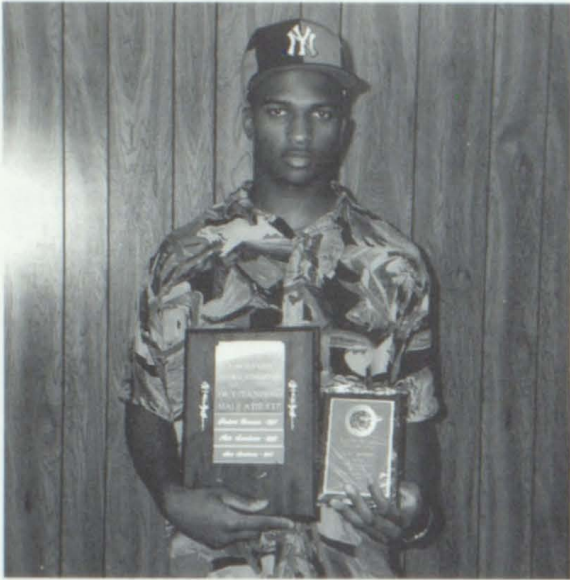
UIL Recognition Banquet

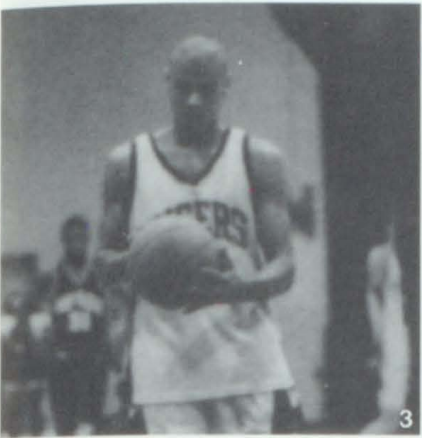

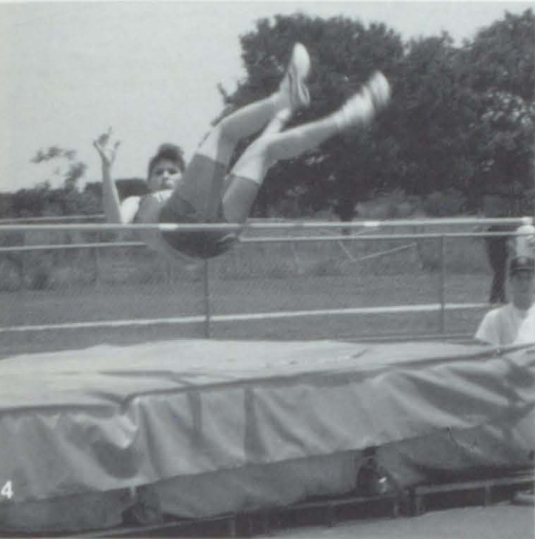

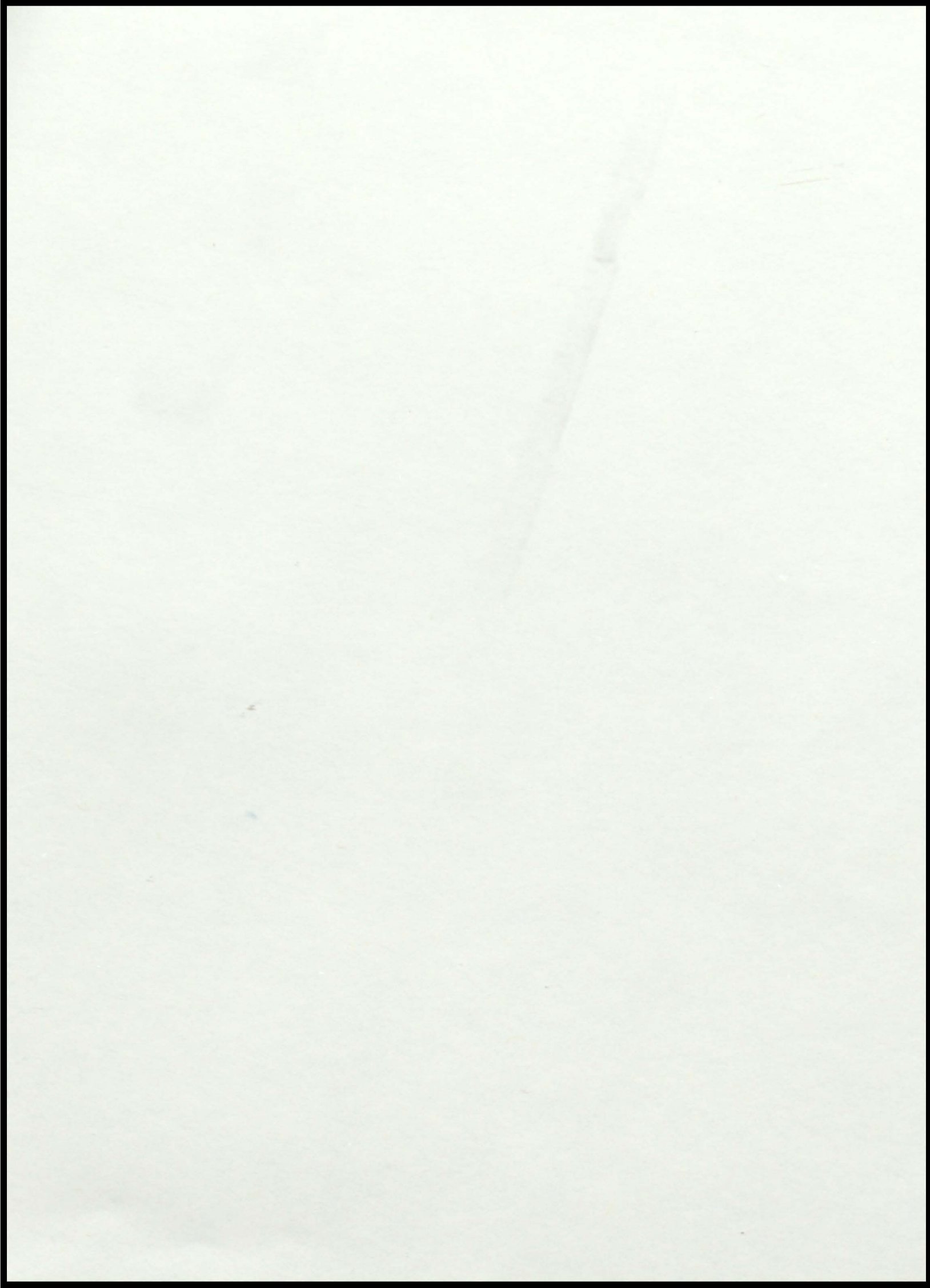
A THOUGHT TO CLOSE ON
