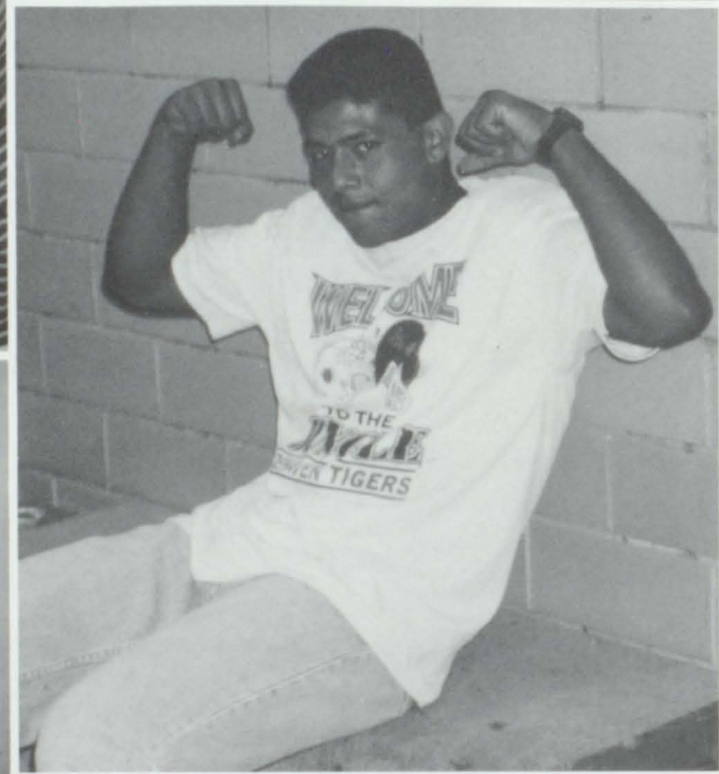

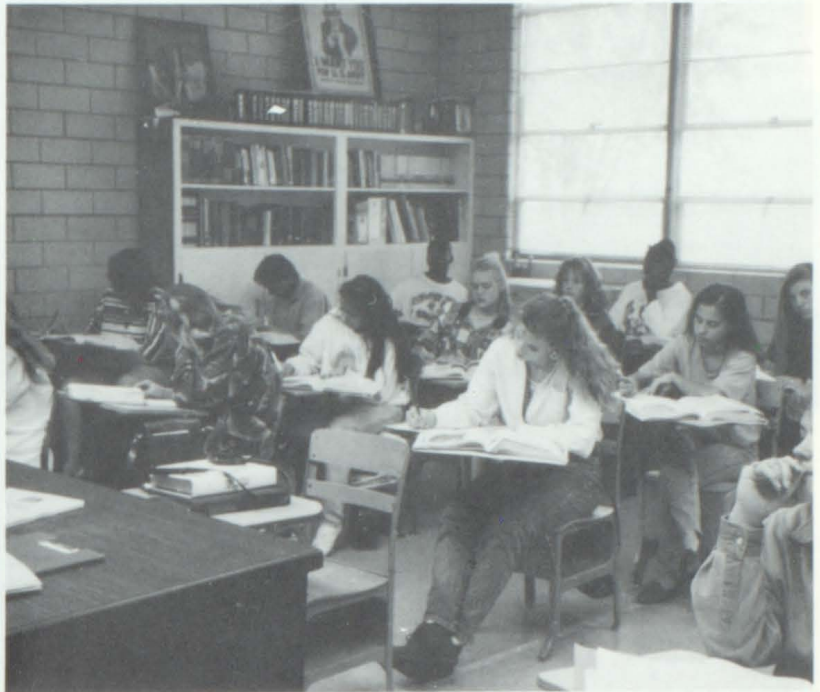

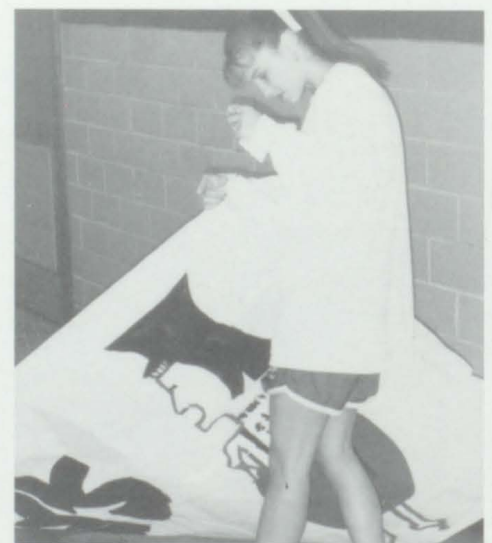

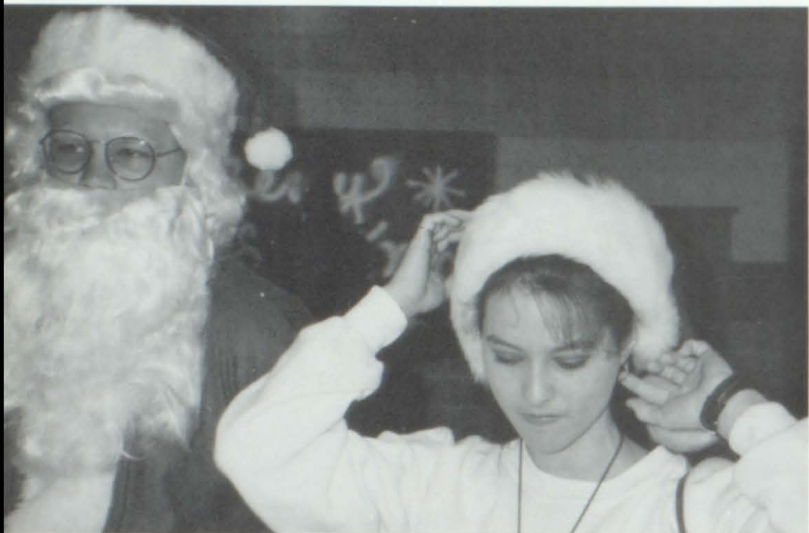

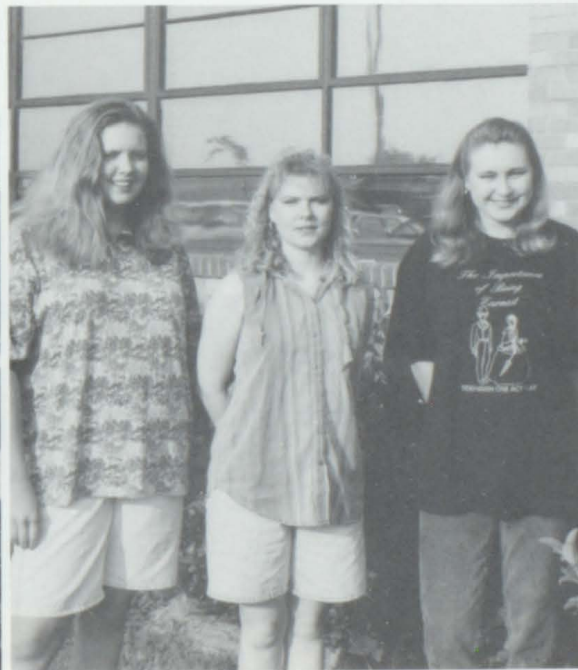

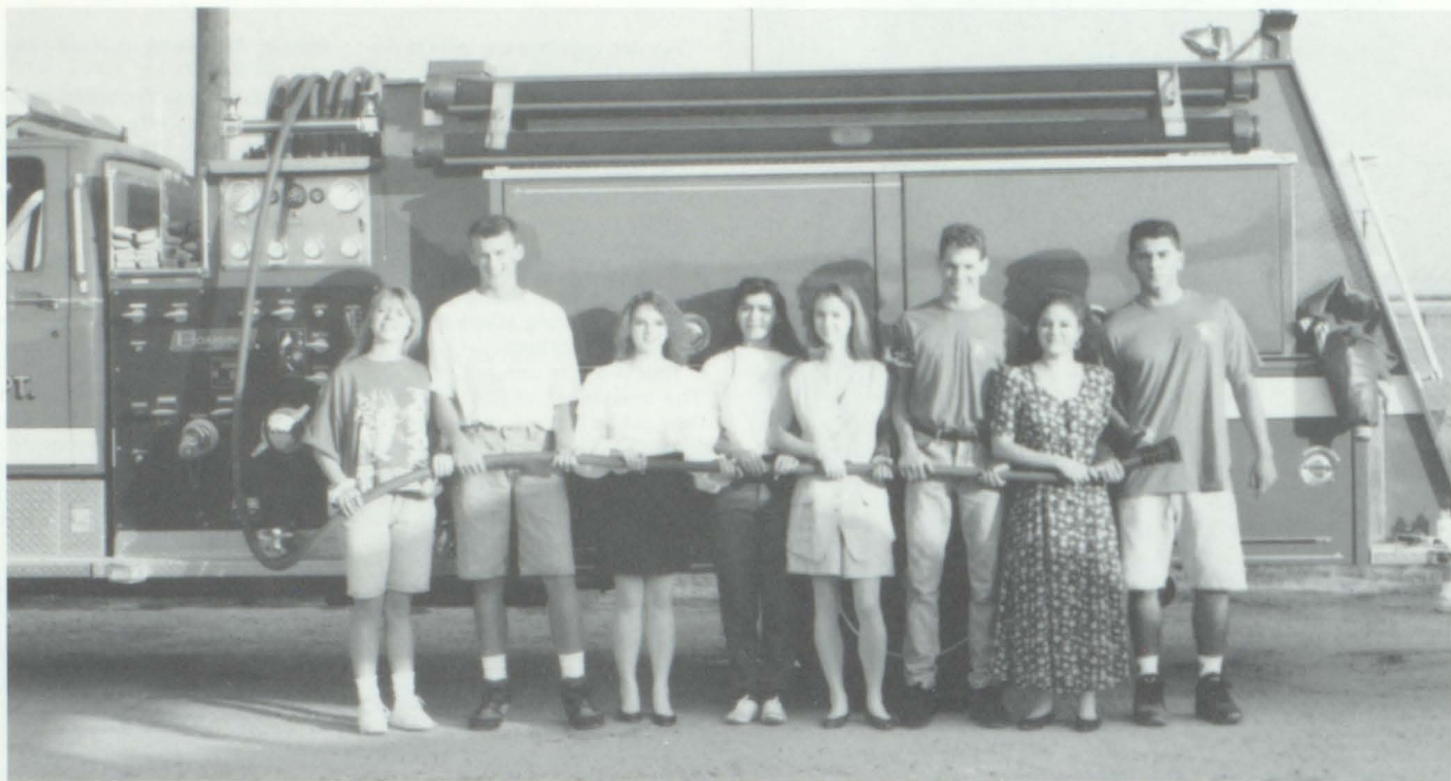

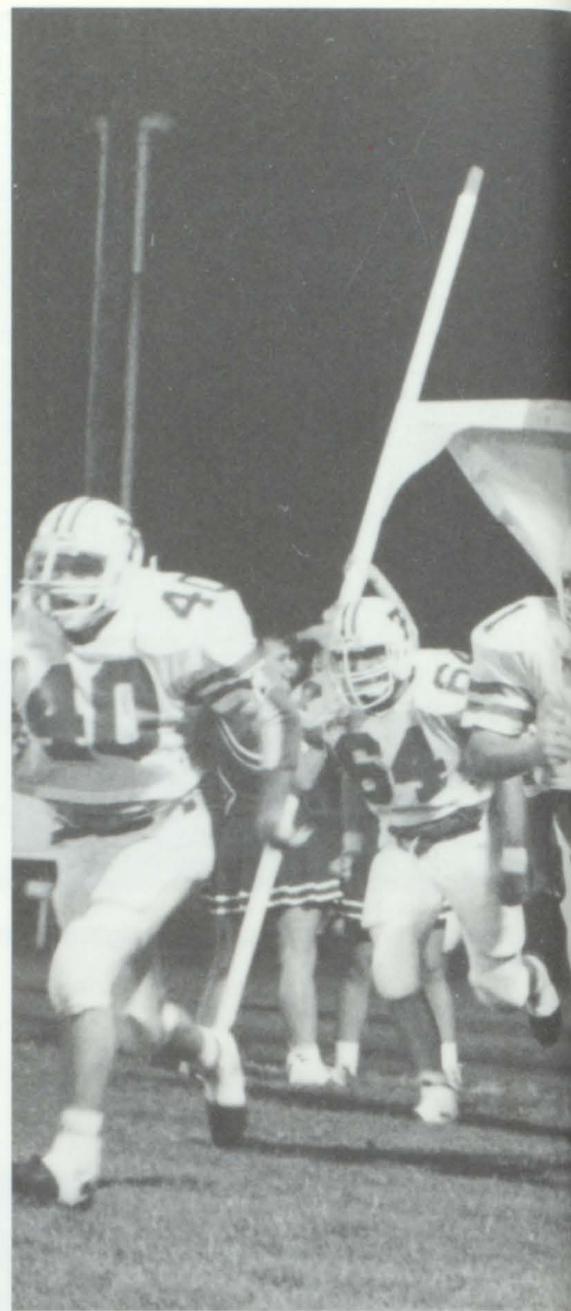
A Battle To The End

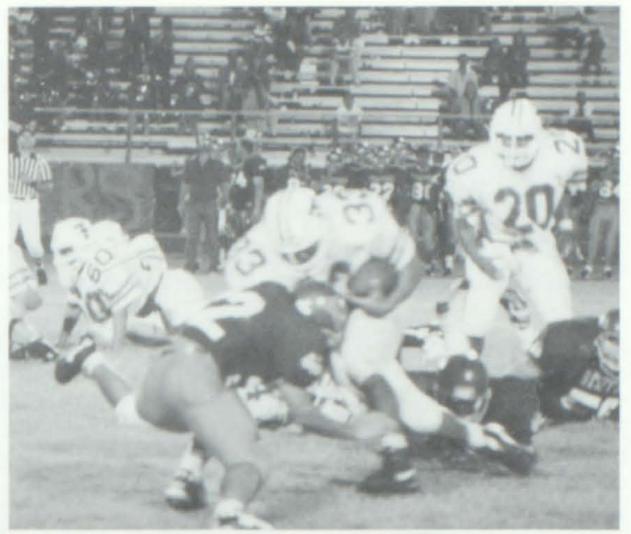

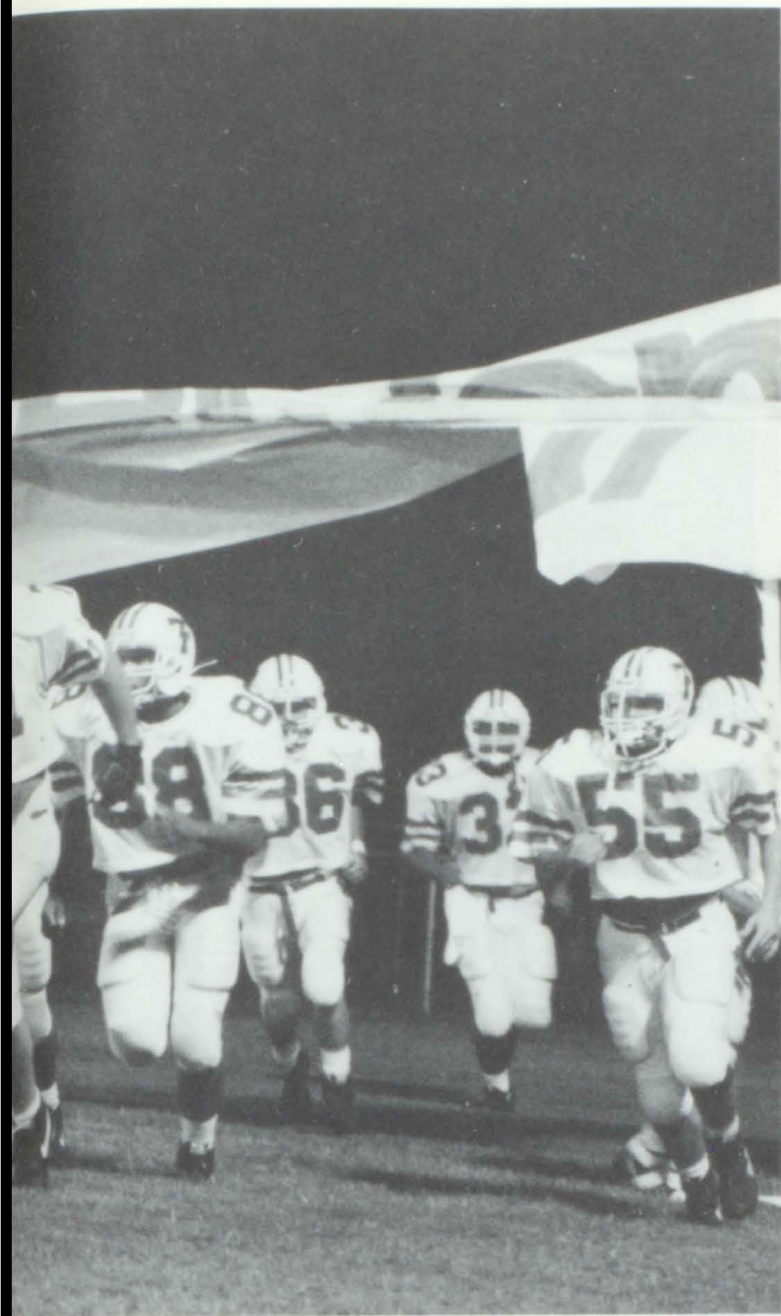

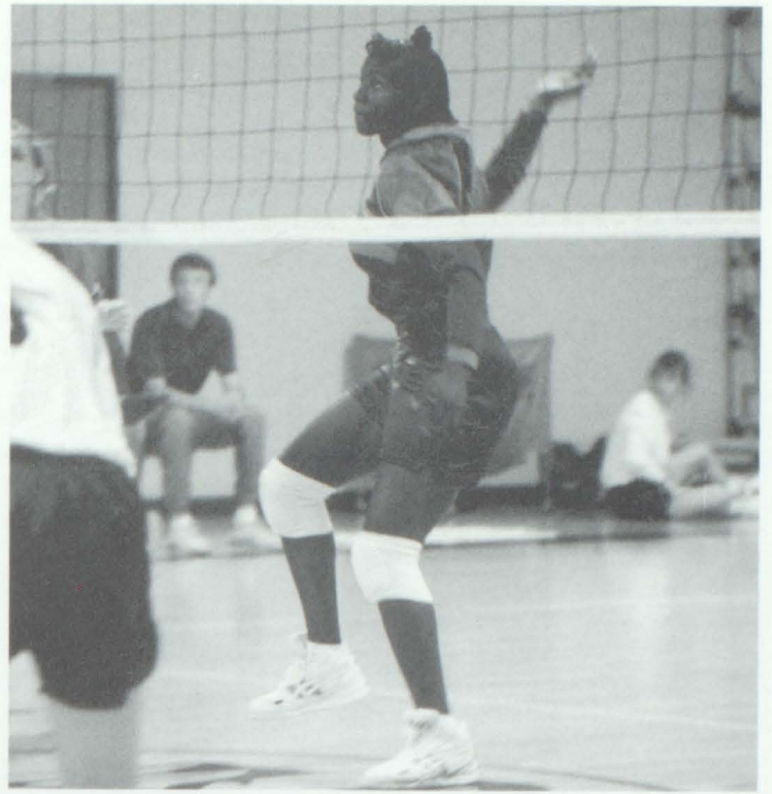

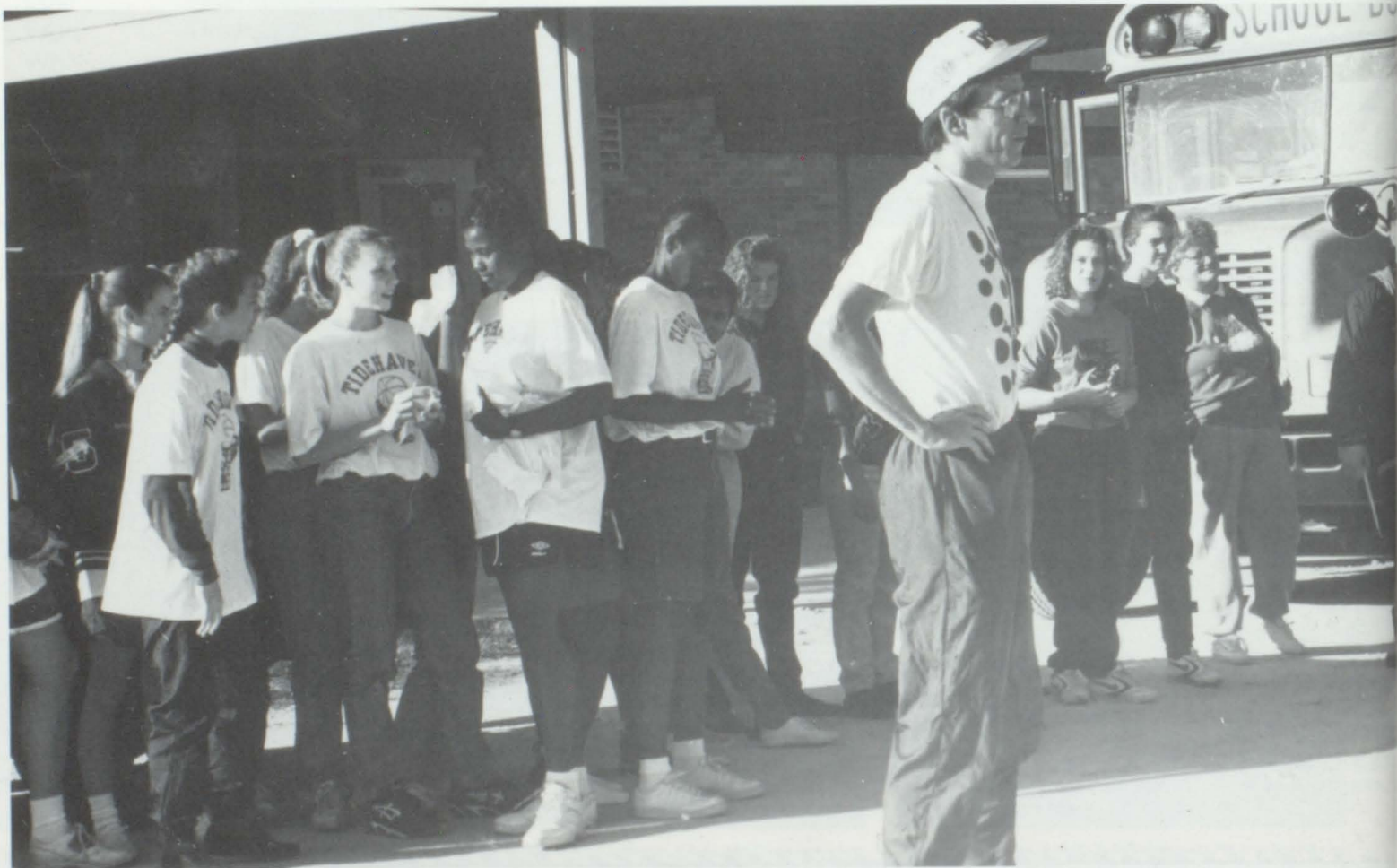

ty players coming up we will be stronger next year."

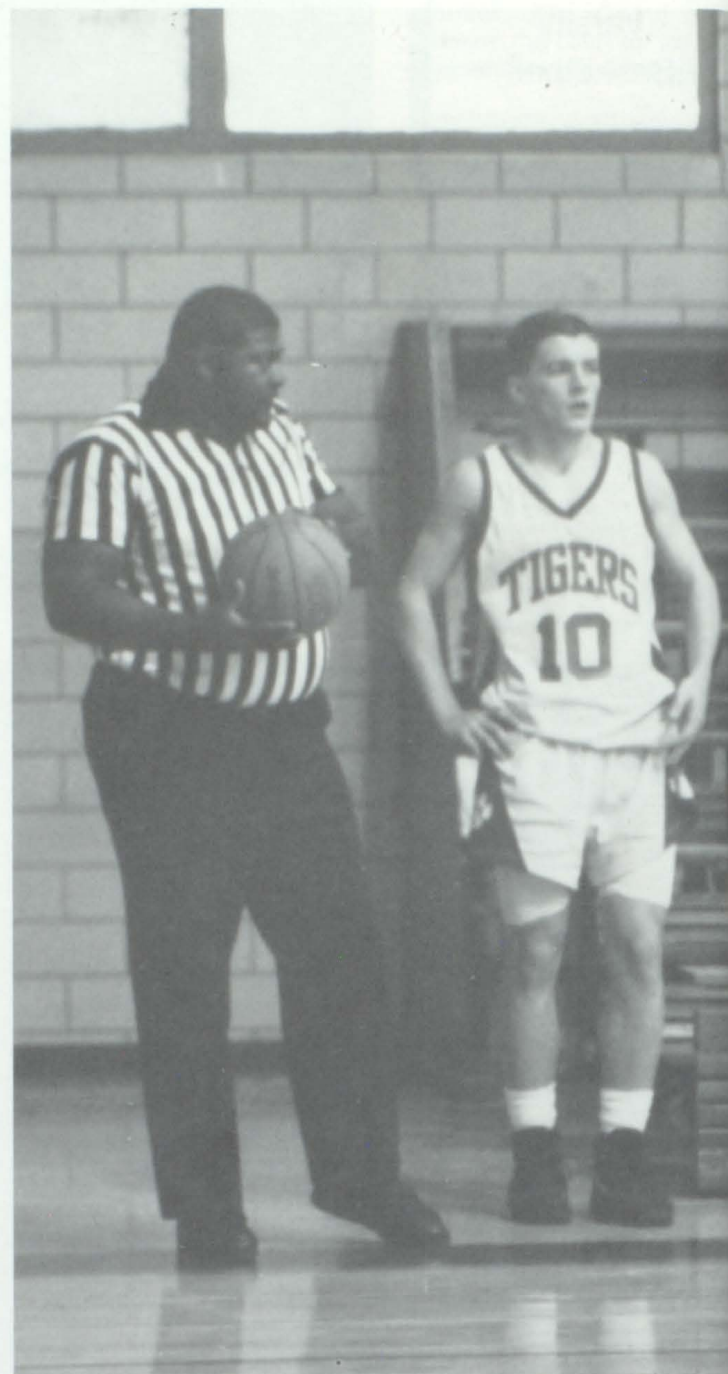

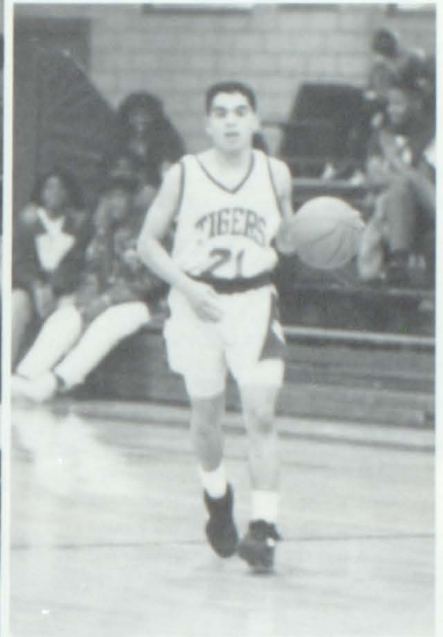

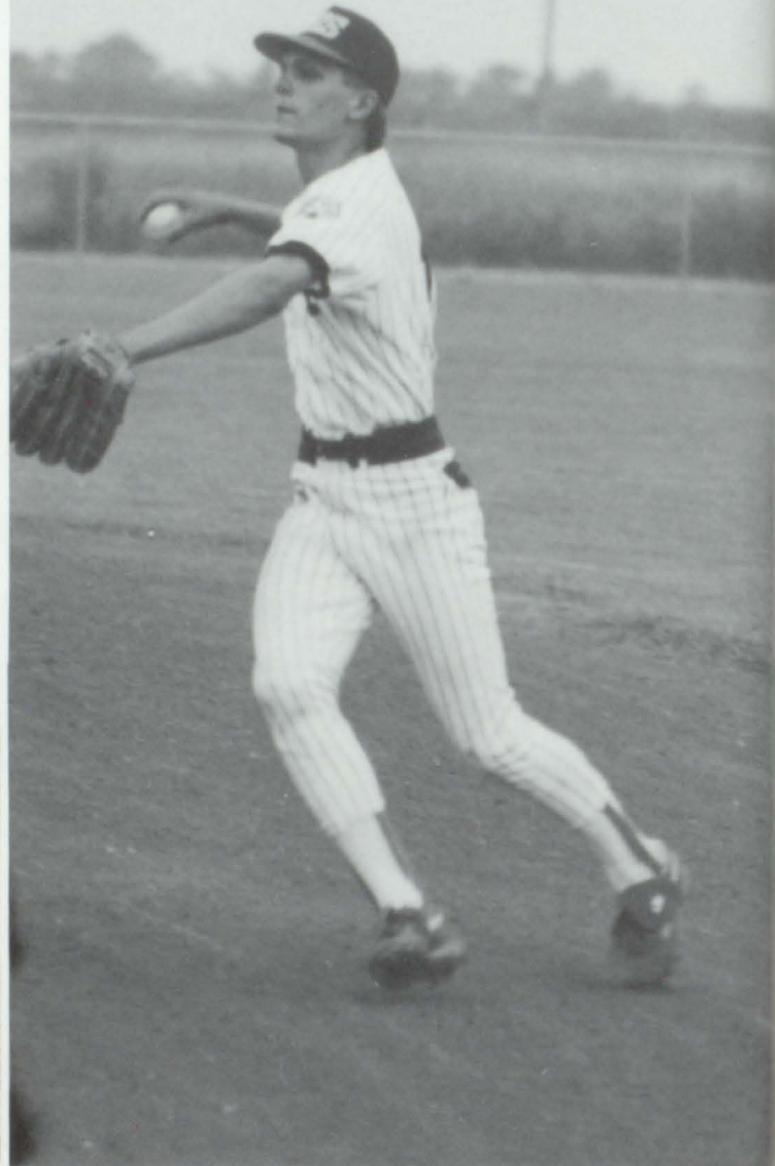
Coach Taska had this to say about the season, "We started

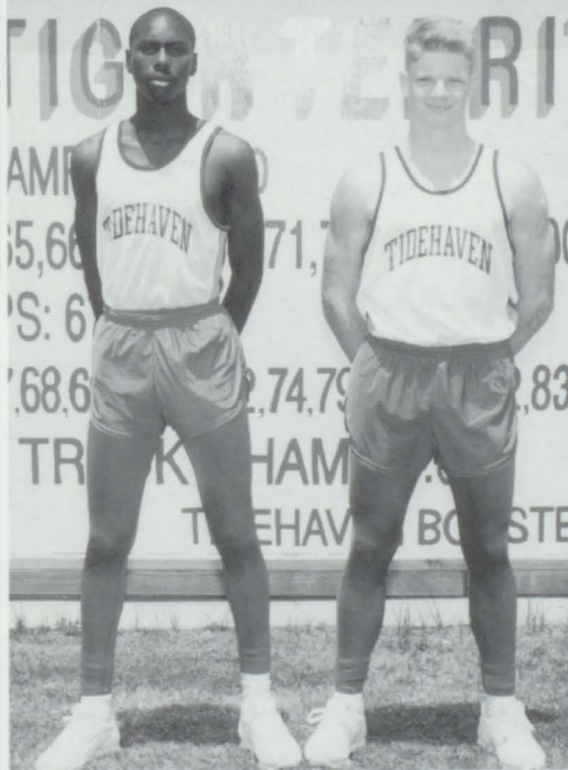

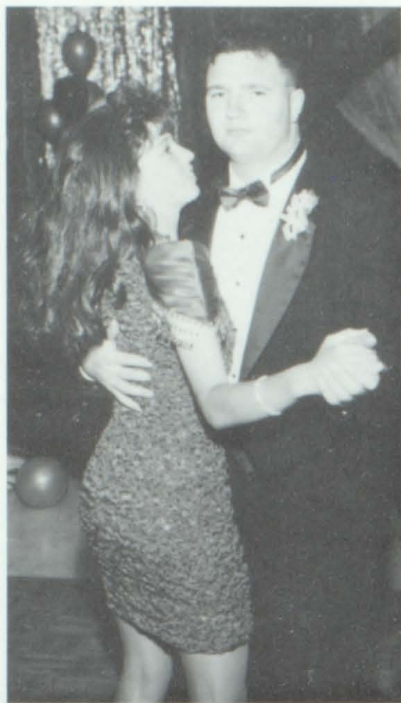

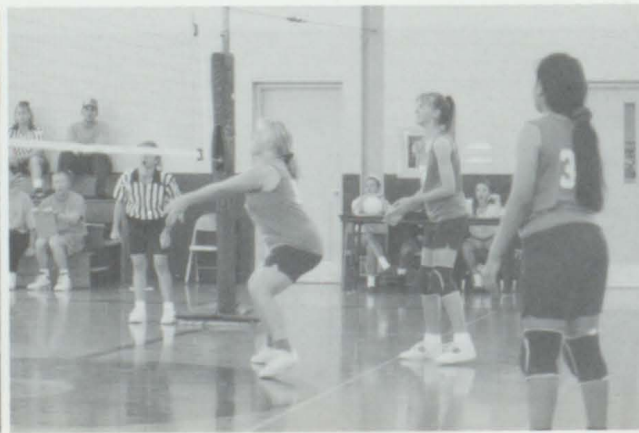
