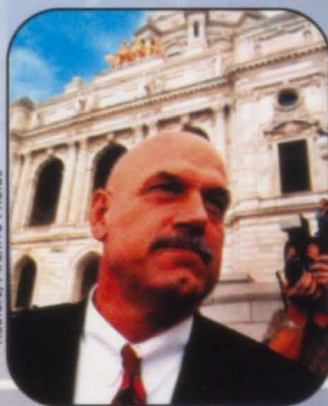

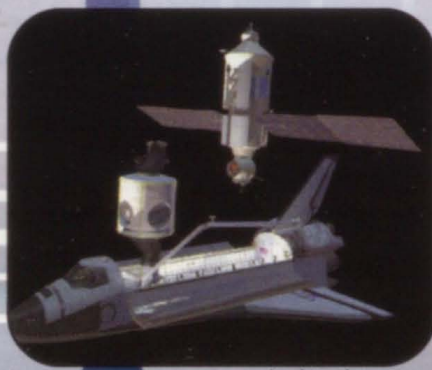
John Glenn

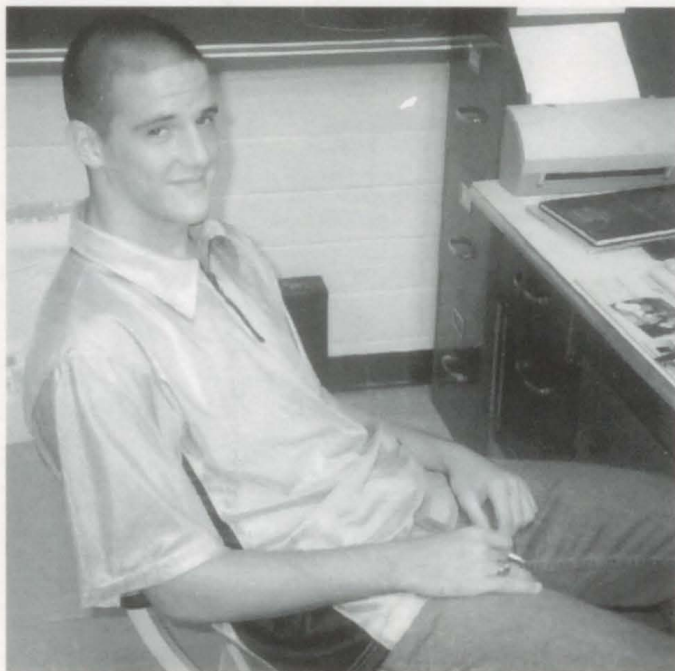
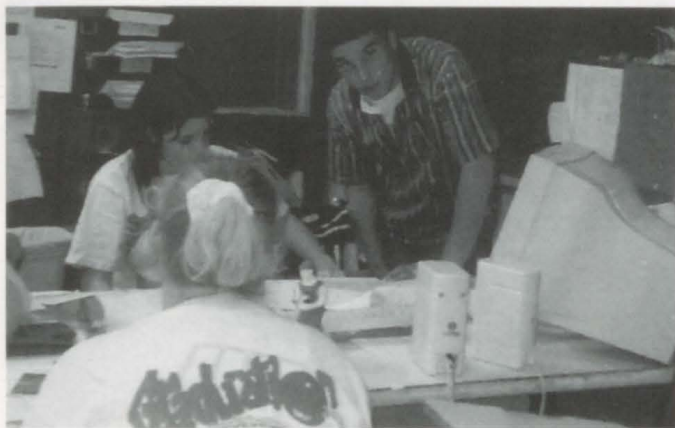
"THE TIGER" YEARBOOK STAFF
