FOURTEENTH: I, Jesse Burford, give and bequeath my ability to get a marriage license before a diploma to Wesley Hanna.


FIFTEENTH: I, Clyde Ashcraft, give and bequeath to Peggy Allen the memory of Charlie Miller.
