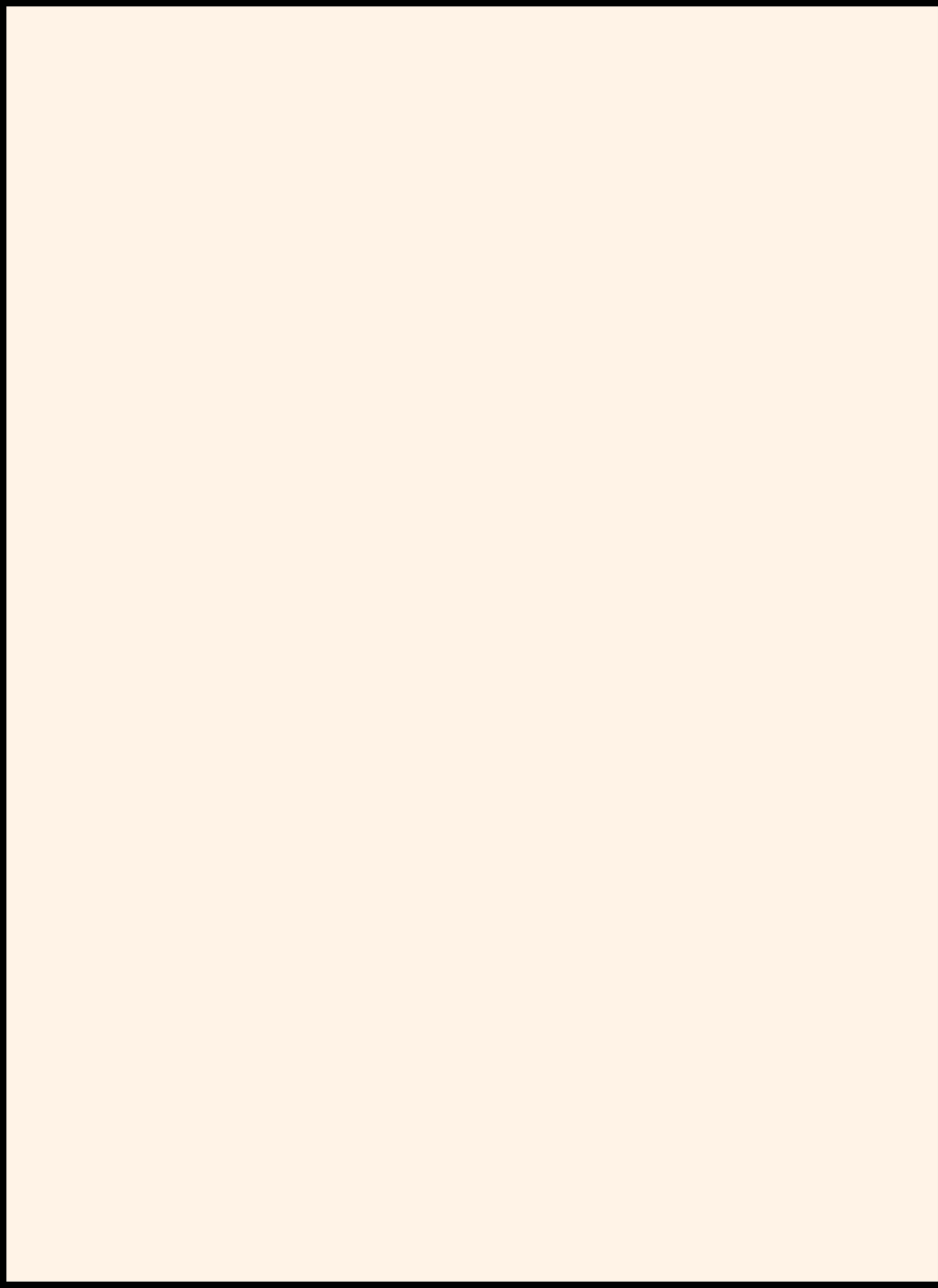

## The Signing of the Declaration

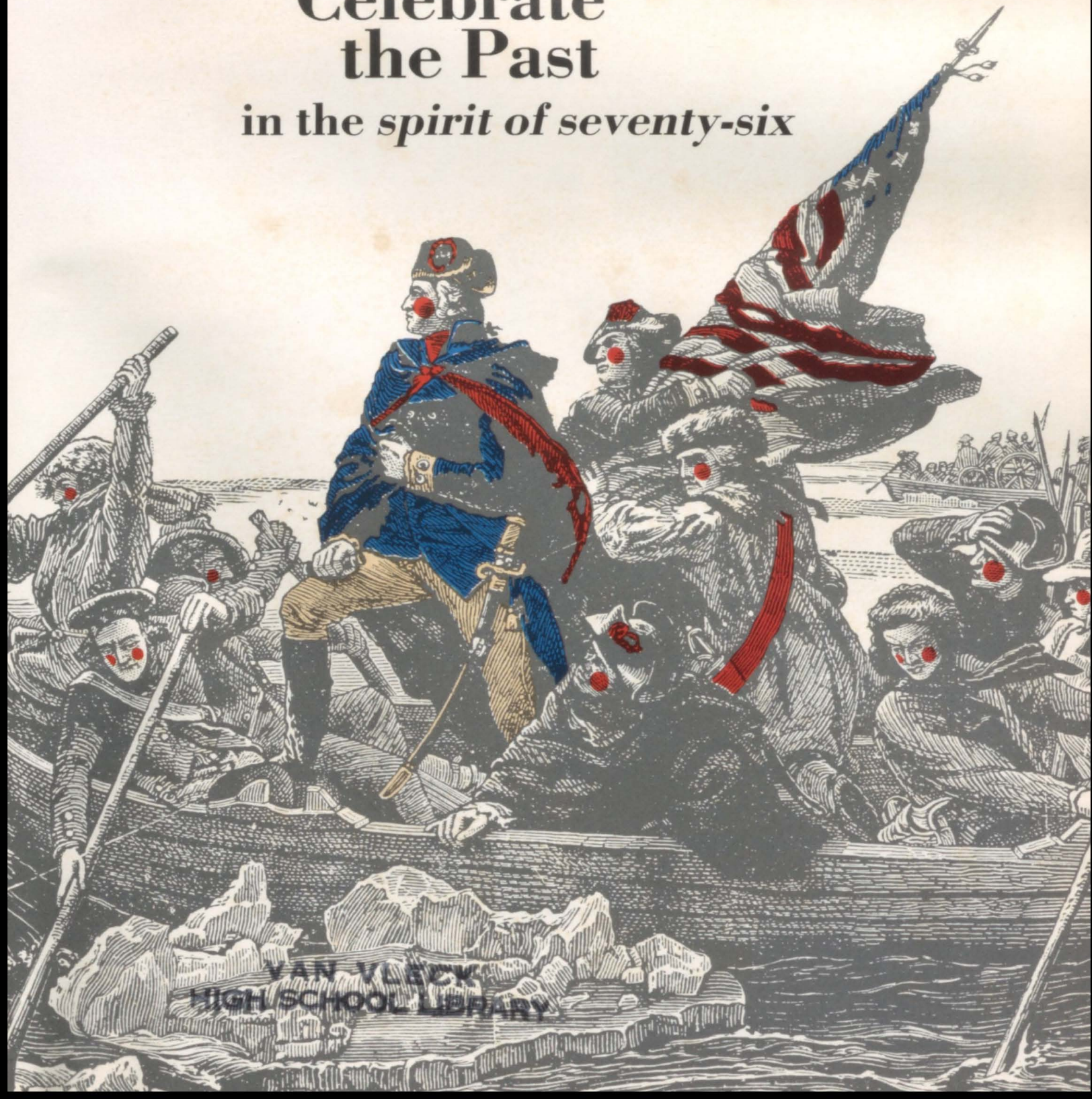
When outraged citizens renounced the hand

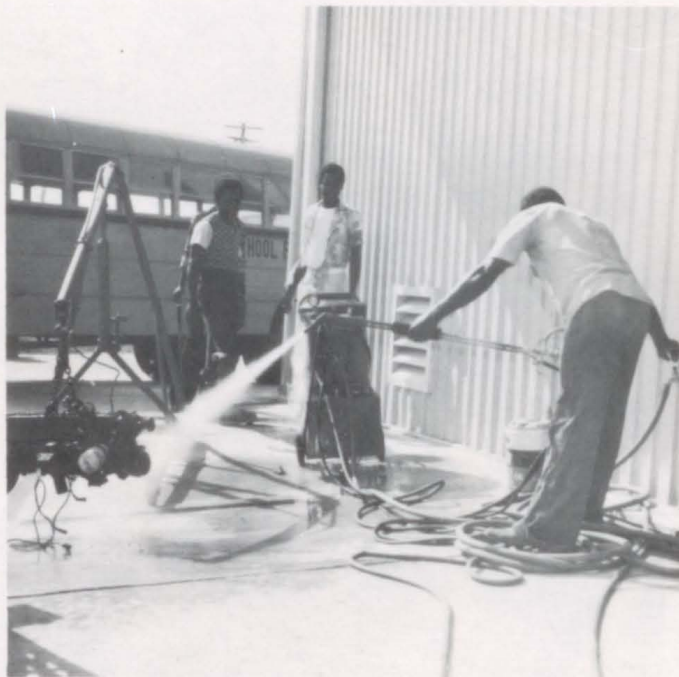

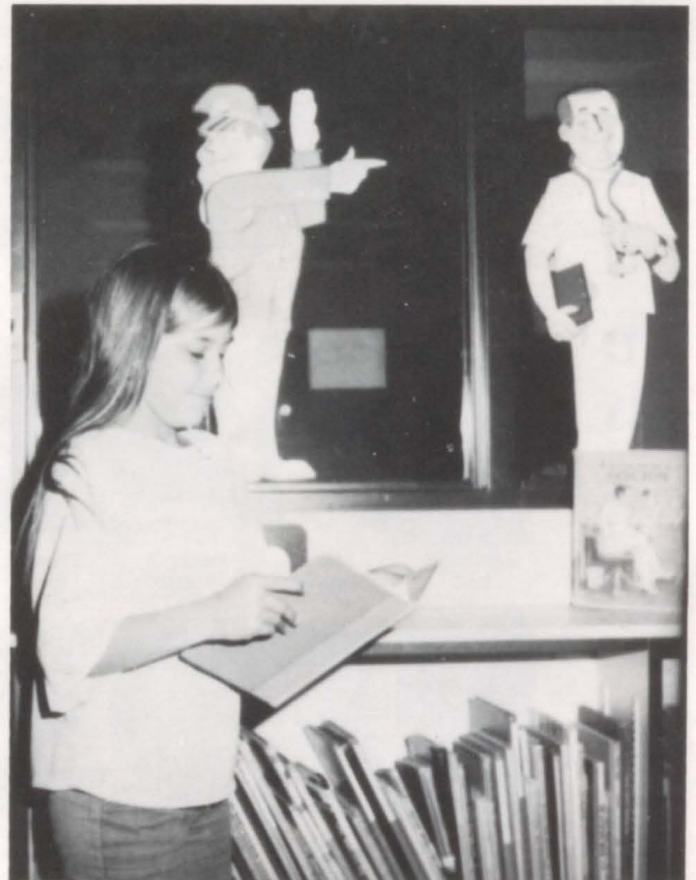
## *Van Vleck Elementary Earns Coveted Award*
