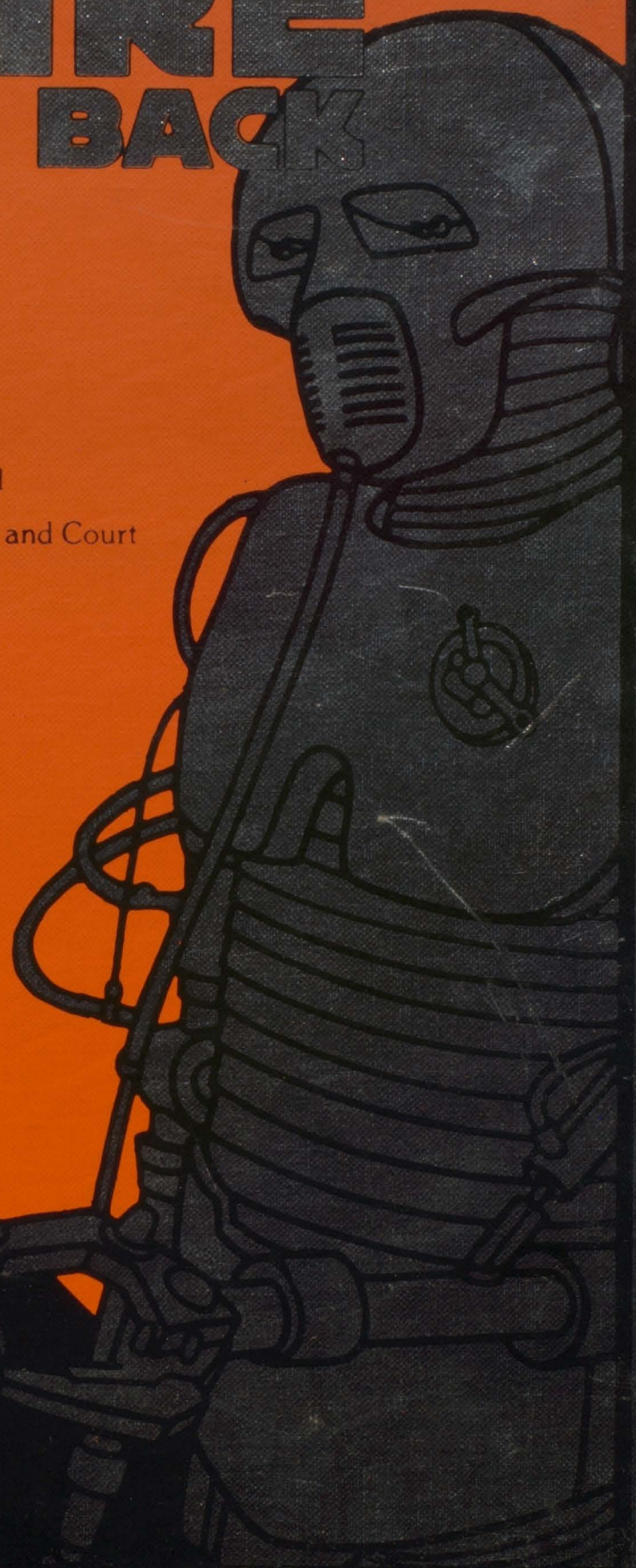

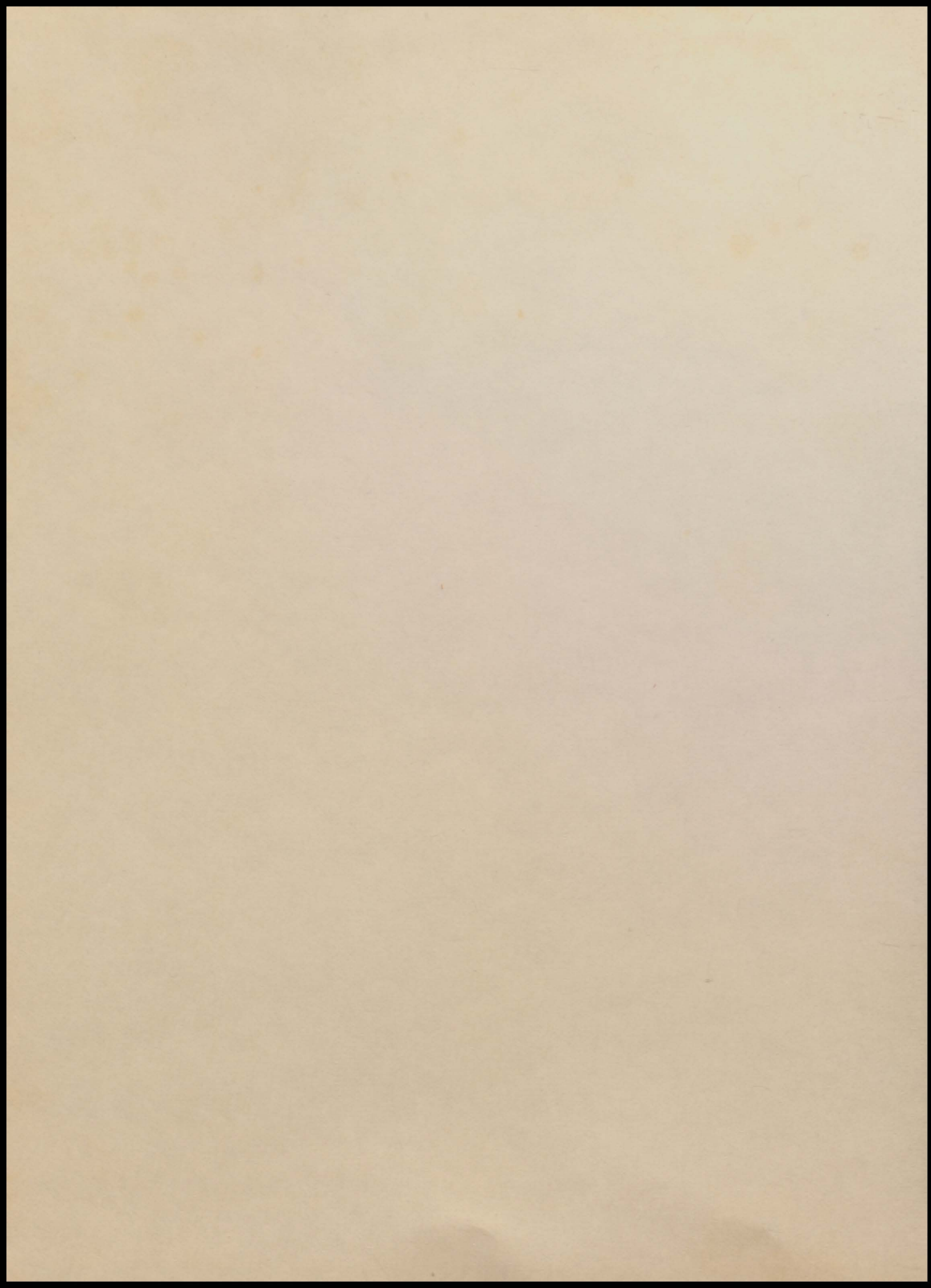


PRESENTATION OF THE 1982 LEOPARD

The game was highlighted by the Homecoming activities, or rather, the activities were highlighted by the exciting game. The Leopards, once again, emerged victorious with the final score being 18-7. 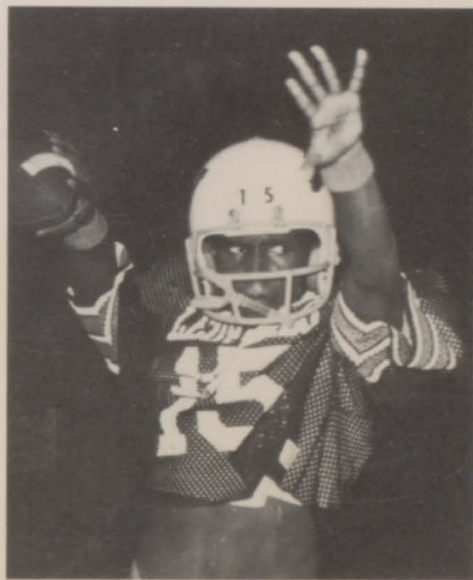
scoreboard in the first half, but the Indians made a strong comeback in the second half to post a win, the final score being Van Vleck 6, Cleveland 12.
