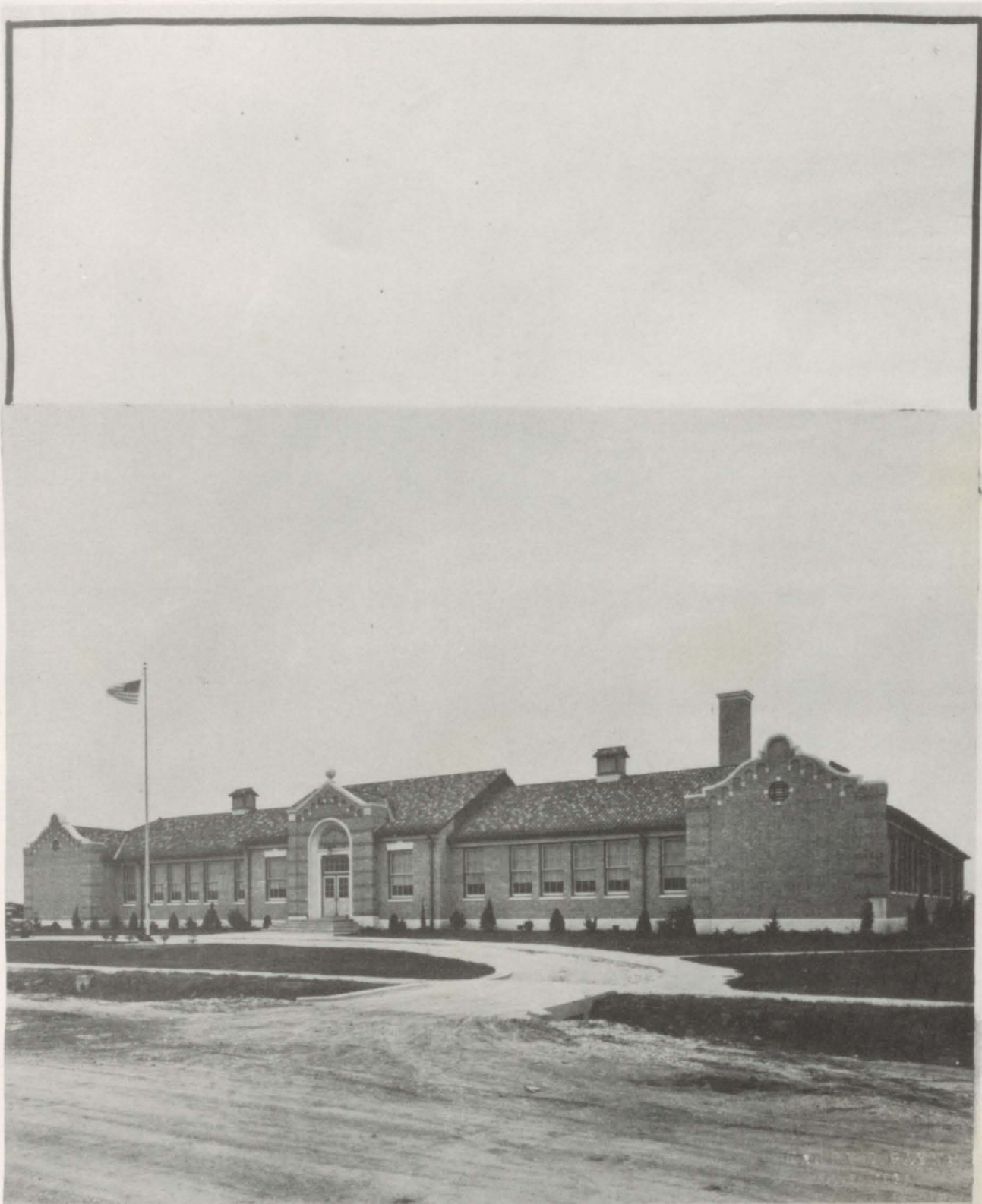
FOREWORD

IN THE DISTRICT MEET, BAY CITY WON BOTH DIVISIONS OF SENIOR BOYS AND WERE DEFEATED IN THE SEMIFINALS IN THE JUNIOR GIRLS. IN THE REGIONAL MEET, BAY CITY WAS DEFEATED IN THE FINALS BY CORPUS CHRISTI IN SINGLES AND BY BISHOP IN THE DOUBLES. COUNTY MEET—BAY CITY WON FROM PALACIOS 117-20. EIGHT RECORDS WERE BROKEN AND ANOTHER TIED.

WHARTON MEET—RICHMOND BEAT BAY CITY OUT 49-39 TURNING THE EIGHT WAY MEET ALMOST INTO A DUAL MEET. IN THIS MEET NINE OLD RECORDS WERE BROKEN THREE OF WHICH WERE BY BAY CITY.

DISTRICT MEET—VICTORIA NOSED US OUT $36\frac{1}{2}$ TO $28\frac{1}{2}$. NO TRACK RECORDS WERE MADE BECAUSE THE TRACK WAS SOAKED FROM HARD RAINS. BAY CITY MADE THE ONLY TWO RECORDS BROKEN IN THE MEET.

REGIONAL MEET—VICTORIA AGAIN NOSED OUT THIS TIME 23-17. PERFECT WEATHER PREVAILED AND A LOT OF GOOD MARKS WERE HUNG UP.

STATE MEET—PORT ARTHUR WON THE STATE MEET WITH 14 POINTS. BAY CITY MADE FIVE POINTS TAKING TWO THIRD PLACES AND A FOURTH. ONLY TWO STATE RECORDS WERE BROKEN.

OUTSTANDING IN THE TRACK EVENTS WAS CAPTAIN WADSWORTH WHO WON THREE FIRST PLACES IN THE REGIONAL MEET AT KINGSVILLE AND TWO THIRD PLACES AND ONE FOURTH PLACE IN THE STATE MEET.
