BAY CITY, 7
THE MILBY BUFFALOES JOURNEYED 100 MILES TO THE HOME OF THE BAY CITY
BLACK CATS FOR THE FIRST GAME OF THE SEASON. THE BLACK CATS WERE NOT IN






