## *Our Campus Buildings*

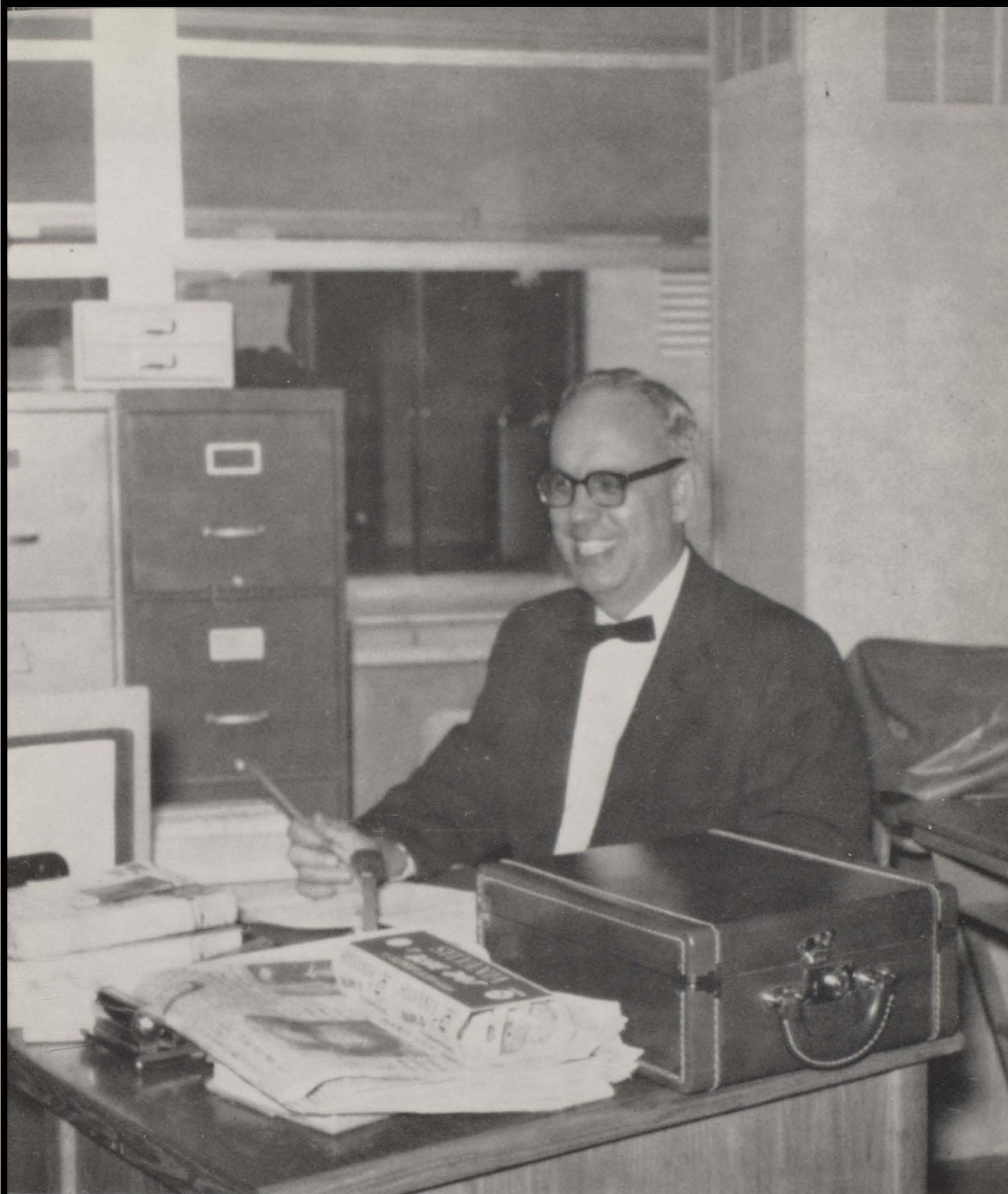
Over the last five years our school has grown from three buildings to a total of seven buildings.

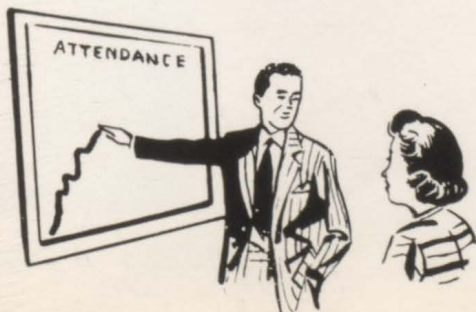

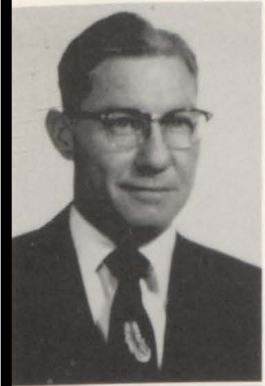


## *Office Personnel of the Administration*
