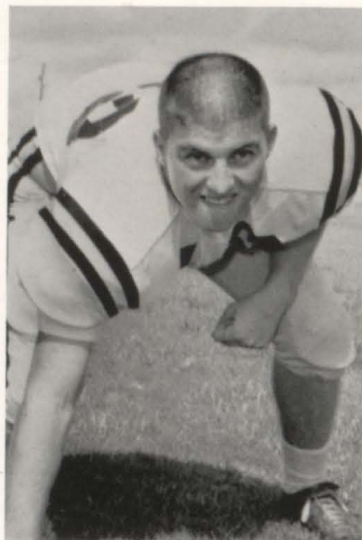
Bay City took advantage of a weak opponent and ran up 404 yds. on 20 first downs while playing the second unit much of the second half.

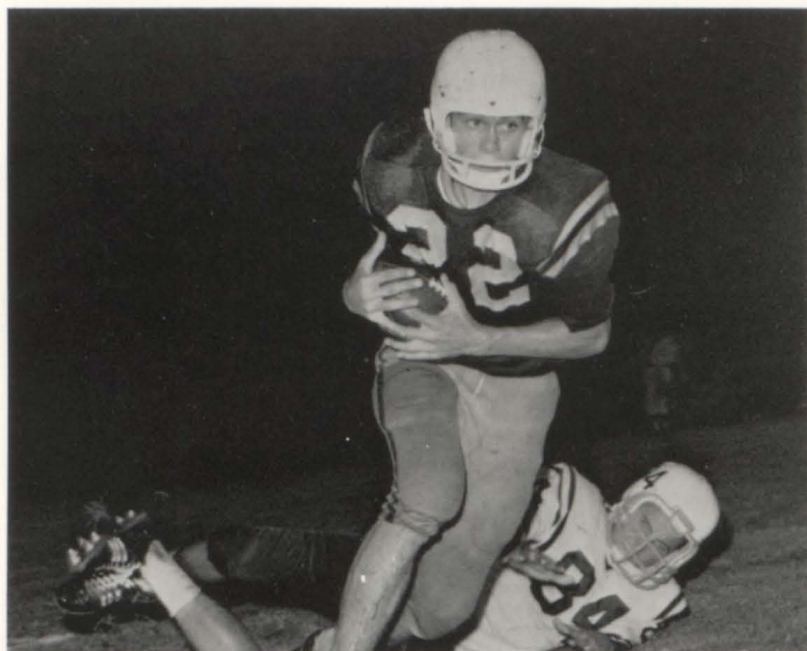
BAY CITY BLACK CATS WIN DISTRICT TITLE
