




Bay City won or tied for District nine (9) out of the first fourteen (14) years Mr. Haley was Head Coach. From 1958 through 1962, Bay City won or tied for District Championship five (5) years in a row.

From the latter part of 1958 season until the Bi-District game with LaMarque in 1960, Bay City was undefeated twentythree (23) straight games.

Bay City has represented its district five (5) times out of the nineteen (19) years Mr. Haley has been Head Coach. Three (3) of these ventures into the State Playoffs were lost at the Bi-District level, but twice Bay City advanced to the quarter-finals.

As of November 10, 1971, Don Haley turned in his resignation as Head Coach of B.C.H.S. Mr. Haley has been with our school for twenty-three years. Our student body both respects and admires those qualities in him as a coach and as a man. He has been a builder of men! Although he might now take his place in the classroom, he will always be known as just "Coach."
