Our new Queen is Miss Sandy Harvey.



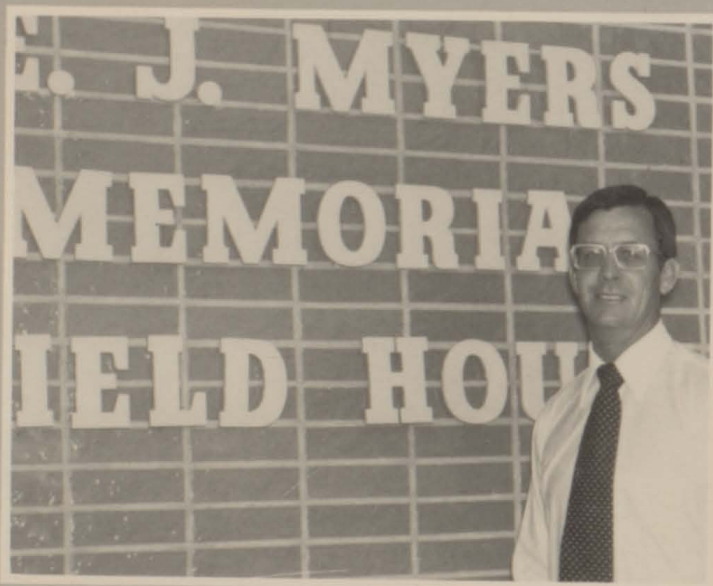

- District meet — the speech department placed first with a total of 75 points

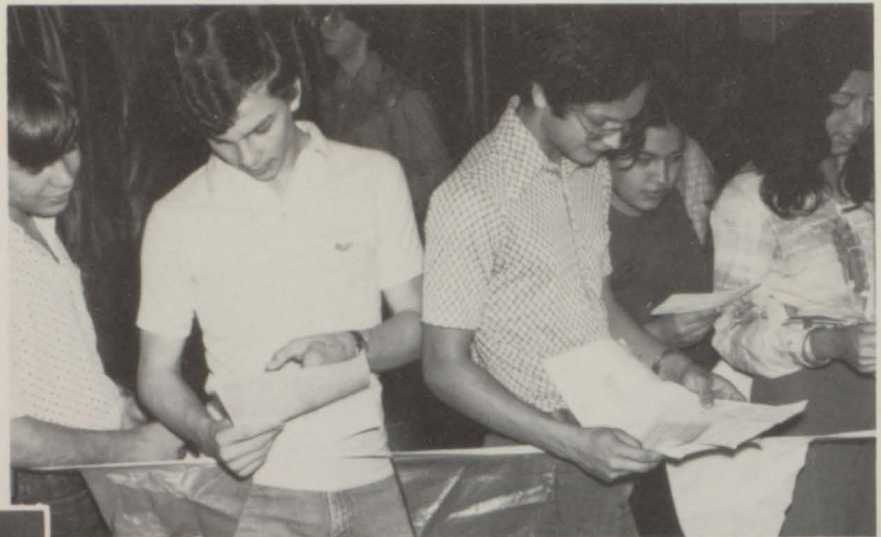
