




















### Homecoming '92






# Dungeoneers





#### Lower Colorado River Watch




Once again, the Chemistry I, Chemistry II, and Biology II classes participated in the LCRA Lower Colorado River Watch. The River Watch network monitors the lower Colorado River for pH, dissolved oxygen, phosphates, nitrates, chlorides, fecal coliform, and several other tests. At the river, the students collect water samples and run several tests. The students drove back from Selkirk and did the more difficult tests like TDS and phosphates, chlorides, and nitrates in the lab.


# Workin'





This year Bay City High School was honored to host a student from the country of Yugoslavia. Zorica Ancic came from Yugloslavia which is located in Eastern Europe just across the sea from Italy. The country has just recently held its first democratic elections because communism was just

overthrown last year. In an interview with the yearbook staff, Zorica said that her country is not very highly developed, but the people are friendly and like to know as much about other people as possible. She further describes her country by saying, "Don't think of our country as a hostile one, because that is not true." The differences in her country and Bay City, as described by Zorica, are the culture and the kids have a bit more freedom. Otherwise, "people have the same worries and happiness, duties, and leisure time." She also said that Bay City is a small town, but she enjoys the people's warmth and appreciation for other people.

Zorica had quite a few adjustments to make when she came to America, but her host family is always willing to help when she needs them. Zorica is staying with Stephen and Letizia King(pictured at left with Zorica). Stephen works at the power plant. Letizia is Italian, and, in the words of Zorica, "a very, very nice lady." have taken her to visit many places since her arrival, including Houston, San Antonio(and the Alamo), Galveston, and Corpus Christi. They also visited the Renaissance Festival(pictured below). Zorica also said, "Whereever we go, I am always welcome to bring one of my friends along. Most of the time I invite Azusa to go with us. She is a Japanese exchange student at BCHS." Zorica said that her host father is at work most of the time, but is always willing to help her with anything she needs, especially if there are language problems. Having a good host family seems to make the transition easier for Zorica.





When Zorica began describing her parents, she started by saying, "They are probably counting every minute and can't wait for me to come back." # Marine Biology

During Mrs. Frankson's Marine Biology field trip, they charted the profile and width of the beach. They gathered water samples to test for how much oxygen, carbon dioxide, salinity, and pollutants are in the water. They seined for organisms and snooped around the jetties for exotic organisms. 





Former flight nurse Barbara Babb spoke to the students at Bay City High School on the consequences of drinking and driving. The effects of her message were worn on the students' faces as they left the auditorium-a range of dazed expressions to tears. Babb pulled no punches in her presentation as she told the students what happens when people drink and drive. During the presentation. Babb described a few of the crashes she had seen as an emergency flight nurse in St. Louis. Missouri, Babb, who has more than nineteen years of criticalcare nursing experience, started speaking at different schools in 1985. Her presentation uses explicit photographs to illustrate the dangers of driving while under the influence of alcohol.



Rabb explained what happens to a body when a vehicle hits a tree going 40 miles per hour and the driver is not wearing a seat belt. She went on to describe the horror the parents go through when they must be notified that their child has been involved in a serious accident and is either critically wounded or dead. Babb said,"I don't lecture to the students or tell them what they should or should not do. We all know that it is illegal for anyone under 21 to

drink-that's a point I certainly emphasize-but peer pressure to drink sometimes can be tremendous. If a young person drinks, the last thing he or she should do is get behind the wheel of a car."

The program was ended when Mr. Adams announced the opening of a chapter of SADD(Students Against Drunk Driving) at Bay City High School. We should all do our part to help in the fight on drunk driving.

#### WHARTON DAY

Before the assembly, we received a bag that had a food and prize ticket, a pencil, an application, and other information about Wharton. There were three different schools there and each school sat with their own classmates. While we waited for the first speaker, they had a jazz band playing different kinds of music for us.












### JUST WHAT WE ALL HOPED FOR. .




## Show In Town








