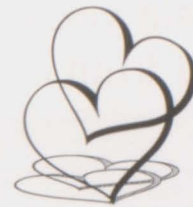
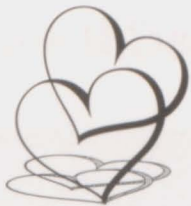








# TEACHER OF THE YEAR
